







## Materials Requirements

### Wood Background

- 2 yards

### Green Border

- 2 yards

### Heart Fabric

- 1/2 Yard

### Backing

- 4 1/2 yards

### Batting

- 4 1/2 yards

### Freezer Paper

### Binding

- 3/4 Yards

## General Notes

- The finished size is 48" X 63"
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4 inch unless specified
- Print paper piecing templates on letter size (8 1/2" x 11") making sure to print on actual size or 100%

## Cut Your Fabric

### Wood Background Fabric

- 38 1/2" X 53" rectangle

### Green Border

- Two 5 1/2" X 38 1/2" strips
- Two 5 1/2" X 63 1/2" strips

### Heart Fabric

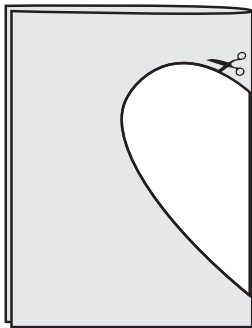
- Cut out heart using the template

### Binding Fabric

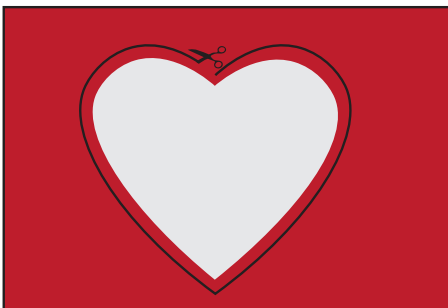
- Six 2 1/2" X WOF Strips

## Piecing your quilt

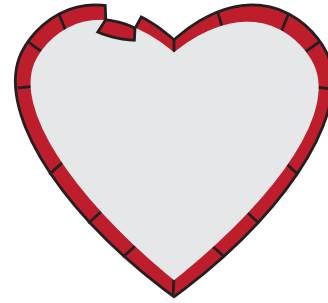
- 1 Fold freezer paper in half and trace on the template with the edge on the fold
- 2 Cut out the freezer paper heart



- 3 Iron the freezer paper shiny side down on the wrong side of the heart fabric
- 4 Cut the heart with a 1/4" seam allowance around the freezer paper



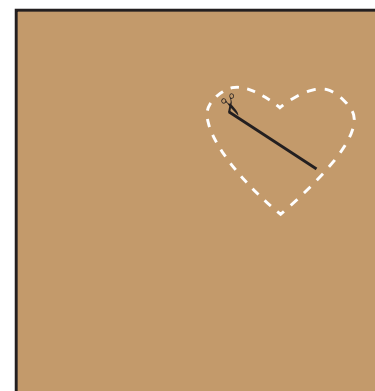
- 5 Clip the edges to the freezer paper and iron over toward the freezer paper side



- 6 Place the heart where desired on the wood background fabric
- 7 Stitch with a straight or zig zag stitch around the heart at a 1/4"



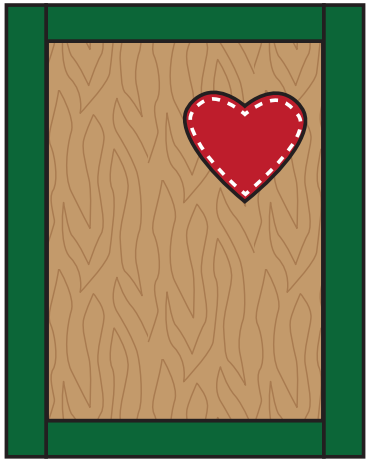
- 8 Cut a 2" slit on the wrong side of the wood fabric within the sewn lines and remove the freezer paper



**9** Pin and sew the two 5 1/2" X 38 1/2" green strips to the top and bottom of the wood piece

**10** Press the seams

**11** Pin the 5 1/2" X 63 1/2" strips to the sides of the center and sew using 1/4" seam allowance



**12** Make your quilt sandwich

**13** Quilt the wood fabric in wood grain lines

**14** Quilt border as desired

**15** Trim excess backing and batting

**16** Bind your quilt with fabric you choose or the extra backing fabric
