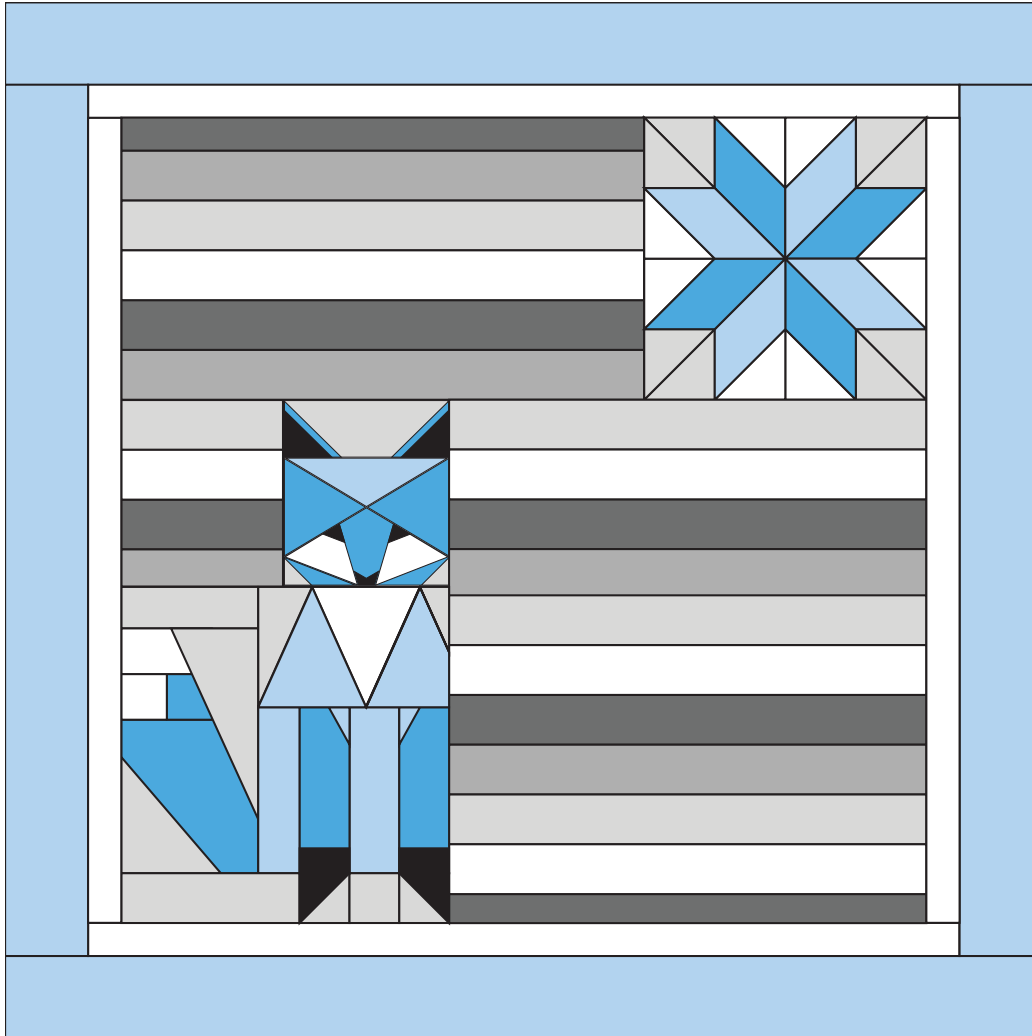


Maverick Fox Baby Quilt



Materials

- Black
1 fat quarter
- White
1 yard for Blocks and Background
2 yards for Borders
- Light Blue
1 yard for Blocks
2 yards for Borders
- Blue
½ yard for Blocks
- Dark Grey
1 yard for Background
- Grey
1 yard for Background
- Light Grey
½ yard for Blocks
1 yard for Background
- Backing
4 yards
- Batting
4 yards

Notes

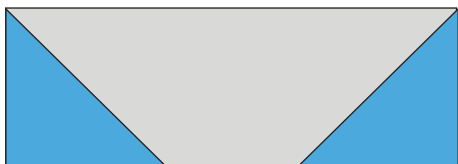
- Finished size: 62"x62"
- WOF = width of fabric
- LOF = length of fabric
- Use a ¼" seam allowance

Cut the Fabric for the Face

- Black
2 squares 3½"
4 squares 2½"
- Blue
2 squares 4"
1 from template F1
2 from template F3
2 rectangles 5½"x2½"
2 rectangles ¾" x 4"
- White
2 from template F2
- Light blue
1 from template F4"
- Grey
1 rectangle 10½"x4
2 squares 2¼"

Piece the Face Block

- 1 Stitch-and-flip the 4" blue squares to the 10½"x4 grey rectangle



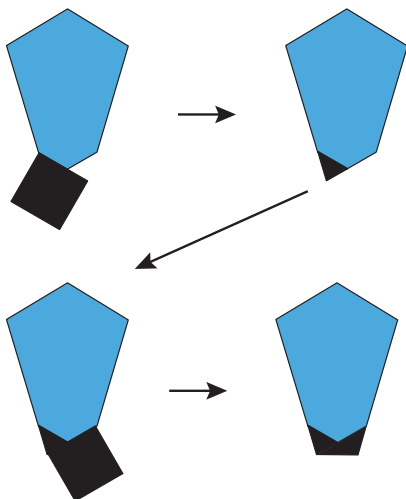
- 2 Stitch-and-flip the 4" black squares to the blue corners of the unit made in step 1



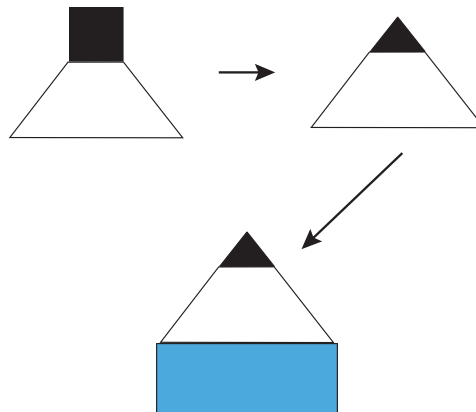
- 3 Join 2 blue ¾" x 4" rectangles to either side of the unit made in step 2



- 4 Join a 2" black square with a short edge of the piece cut with the F3 template. Trim the excess and join an other black square to the unit. Again, trim the excess

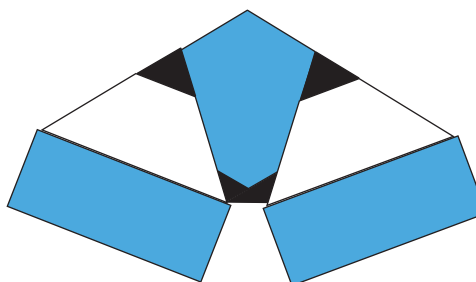


- 5 Join a 2" black square to the short edge of a piece cut from the F4 template. Trim the excess and join with a 5½"x2½". Repeat to make 2

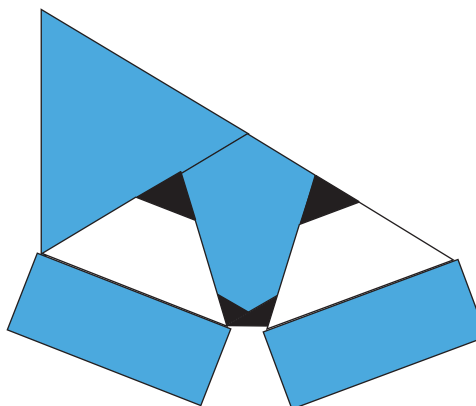

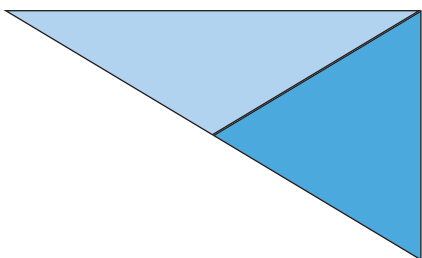
- 6 Join the unit made in step 4 and the 2 units made in step 5



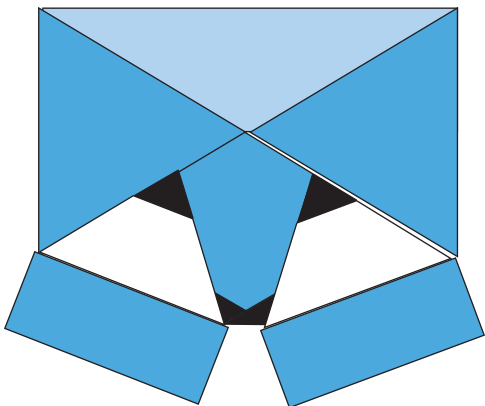
- 7 Join a piece cut with the F3 template and the unit made in step 6



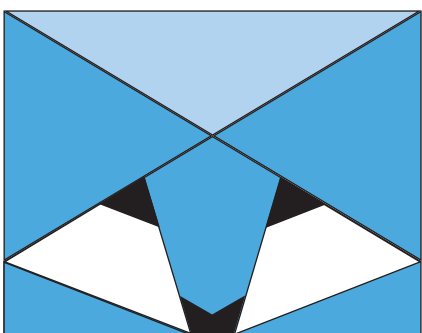
- 8** Join a piece cut with the F3 template and the a piece cut with the F4 template



- 9** Join the units made in steps 7 and 8



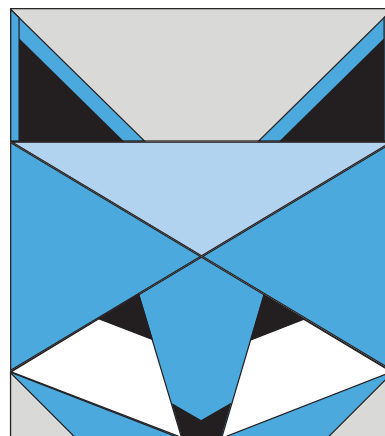
- 10** Trim to 10½"x 8¼"



- 11** Stitch-and-flip the two 2¼" grey squares to the bottom corners



- 12** Join the units from steps 3 and 11

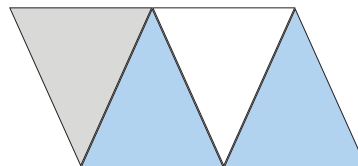


Cut the Fabric for the Body

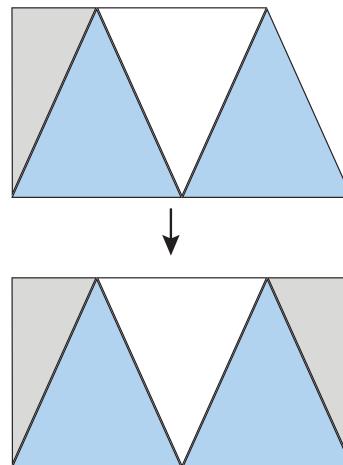
- Light Blue
 - 2 from template B1
 - 2 squares 2"
 - 1 rectangle 3"x10½"
 - 1 rectangle 3½"x10½"
- Grey
 - 1 from template B1
 - 1 from template B5
 - 1 square 10"
 - 1 rectangle 3"x8 ¾"
 - 1 rectangle 3½"x11 ¼"
 - 1 square 3½"
 - 1 square 4½"
- White
 - 1 from template B1
 - 1 from template B2
 - 1 square 3¼"
- Blue
 - 2 rectangle 3½"x9"
 - 1 from template B3
 - 1 from template B4
- Black
 - 2 rectangle 3½"x2"
 - 1 square 4½"

Piece the Body Block

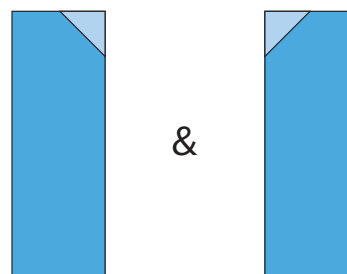
- 13** Join the grey, blue, and white pieces that were cut with the B1 template



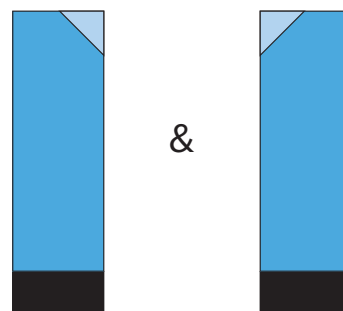
- 14** Trim the grey edge and join to the other side



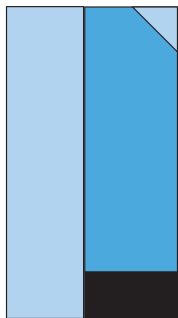
- 15** Stitch-and-flip one 2" light blue square to the right side of a 3½"x9" blue rectangle and one 2" light blue square to the left side of another 3½"x9" blue rectangle



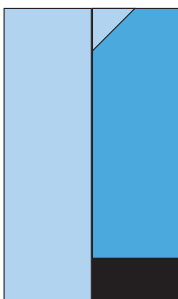
- 16** Join a 3½"x2" black rectangle to each of the units made in step 15



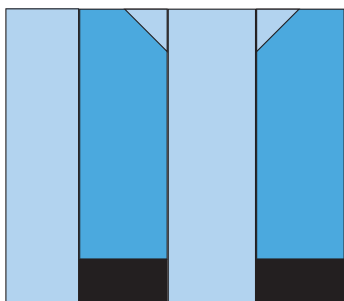
17 Join the 3"x10½" rectangle and the unit from step 16 with the light blue triangle on the right



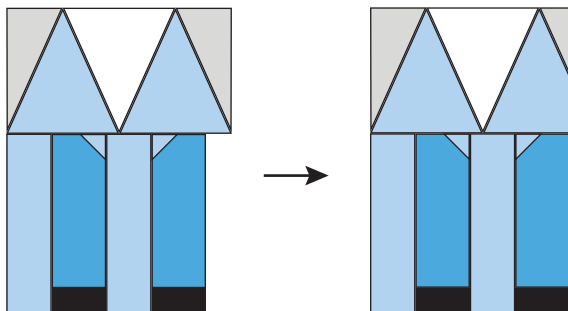
18 Join the 3½"x10½" rectangle and the unit from step 16 with the light blue triangle on the left



19 Join the units from steps 17 and 18



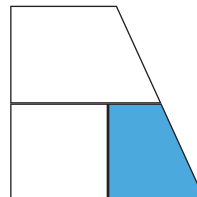
20 Join the units from steps 14 and 19 Trim to 12"x17¾"



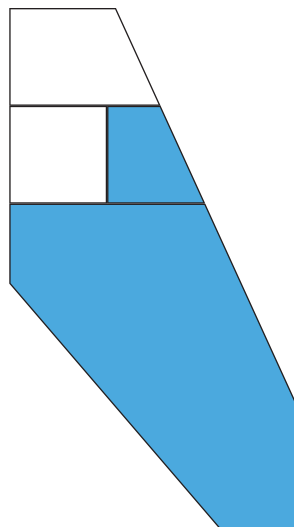
21 Join the 3¼" white square and the piece cut with template B3



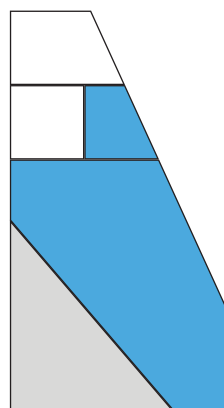
22 Join the unit from step 21 and the piece cut with template B2



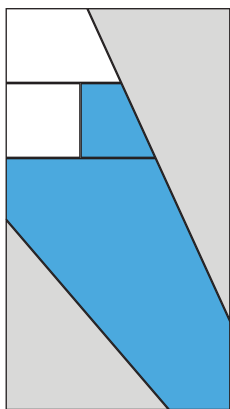
23 Join the unit from step 22 and the piece cut with template B4



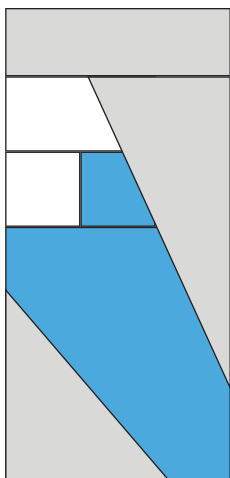
24 Stitch and flip the 10" square to the unit from step 23



25Join the unit from step 24 and the piece cut from the B5 template



26Join the unit from step 25 and the 3"x8 3/4" grey rectangle



27Create 2 at a time half square triangles using the 4 1/2" grey square and 4 1/2" black square. Trim to 3 1/2" squares

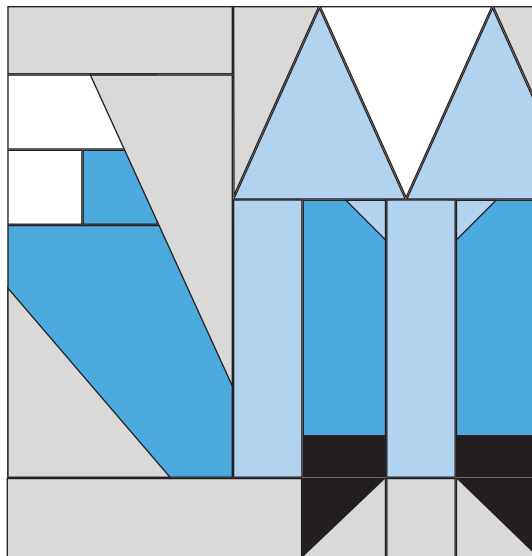

28Join the units from step 27, the 1 rectangle 3 1/2"x11 1/4" and the 3 1/2" square



29Join the units from steps 20, 26, and 28

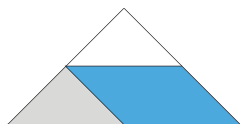


Cut the Fabric for the Star

- Blue
4 from template S1
- Light Blue
4 from template S2
- Grey
8 from template S3
- White
8 from template S3

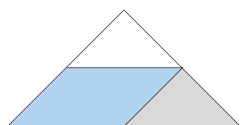
Piece the Star Block

30 Join a blue, white and grey piece. Repeat 4 times



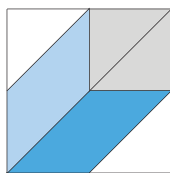
Make 4

31 Join a light blue, white and grey piece. Repeat 4 times



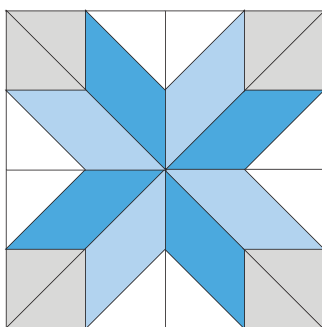

33 Join all units from step 32

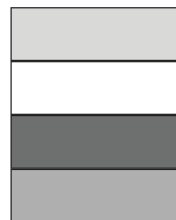


Cut the Fabric for Background and Borders

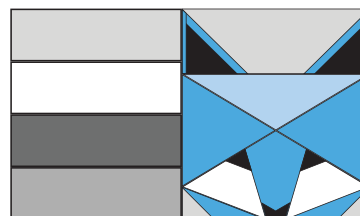
- Dark Grey
5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF
1 rectangle $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $10\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Grey
5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF
1 rectangle $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $10\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Light Grey
5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF
1 rectangle $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $10\frac{1}{4}$ "
- White
5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF
1 rectangle $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $10\frac{1}{4}$ "
4 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x LOF
- Light Blue
4 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF

Assemble your Quilt

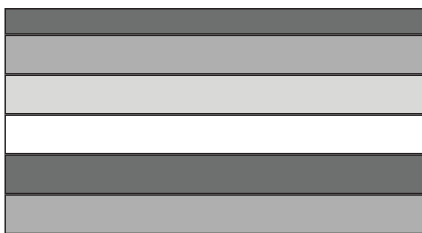
34 Join the light grey, white, dark grey and grey $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $10\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles



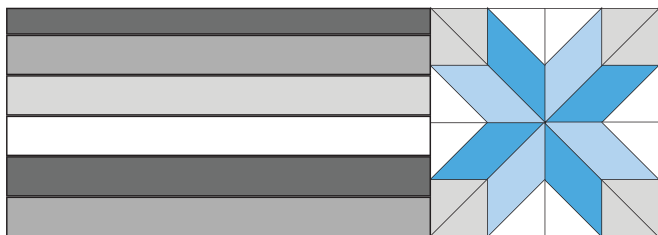
35 Join the unit from step 34 with the Face Block. Trim to $11\frac{3}{4}$ "x $19\frac{1}{4}$ "



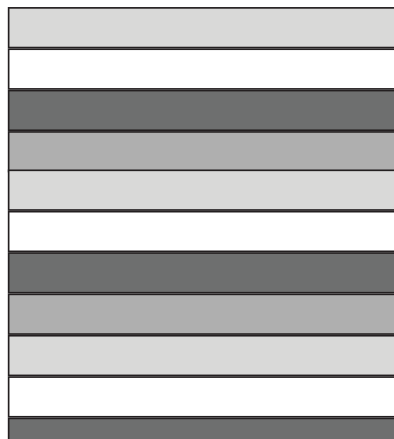
36Join 3½"x WOF strips in the following order: dark grey, grey, light grey, white, dark grey, grey



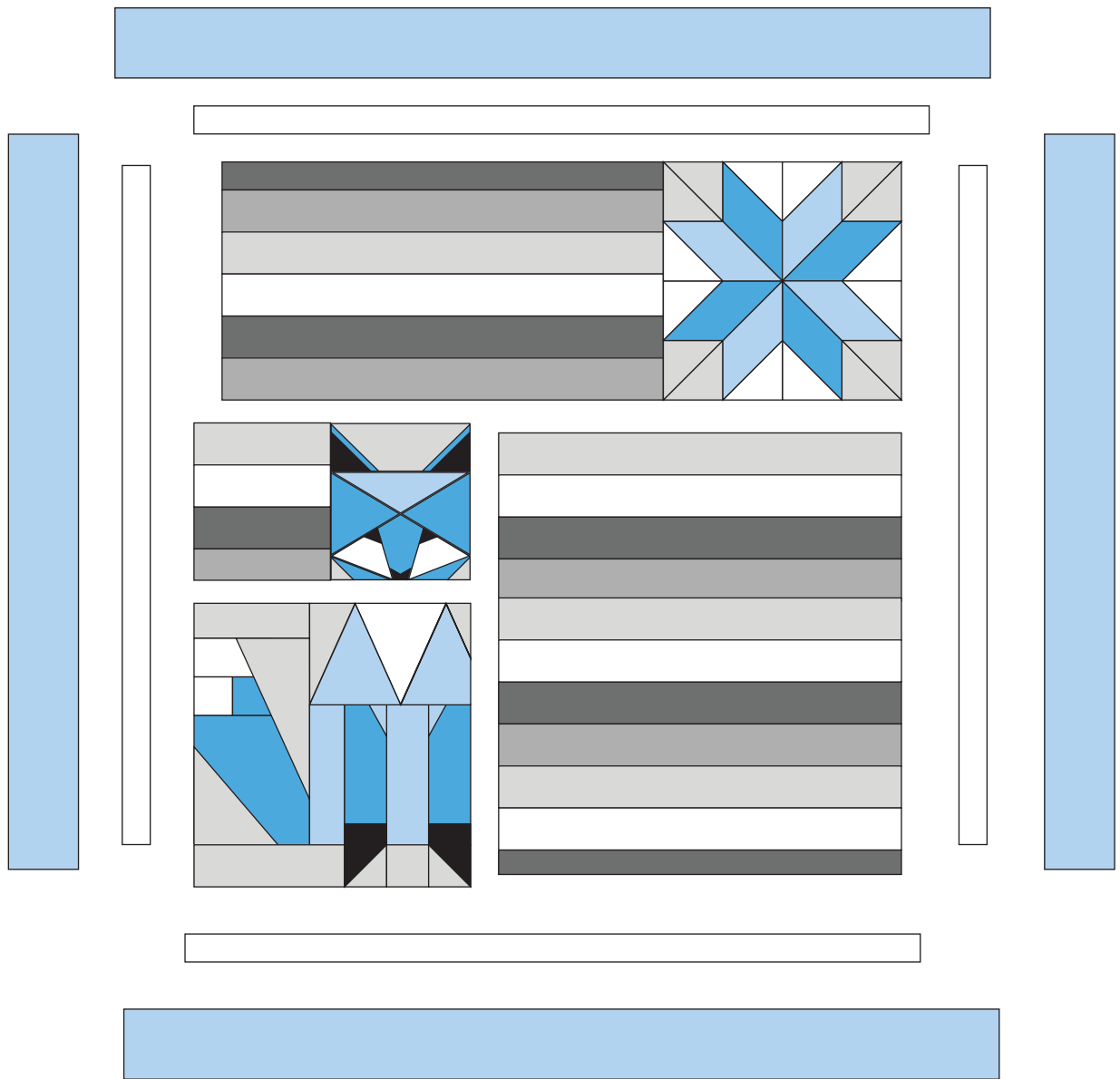
37Join unit from step 36 and star block. Trim to 17½"x49"



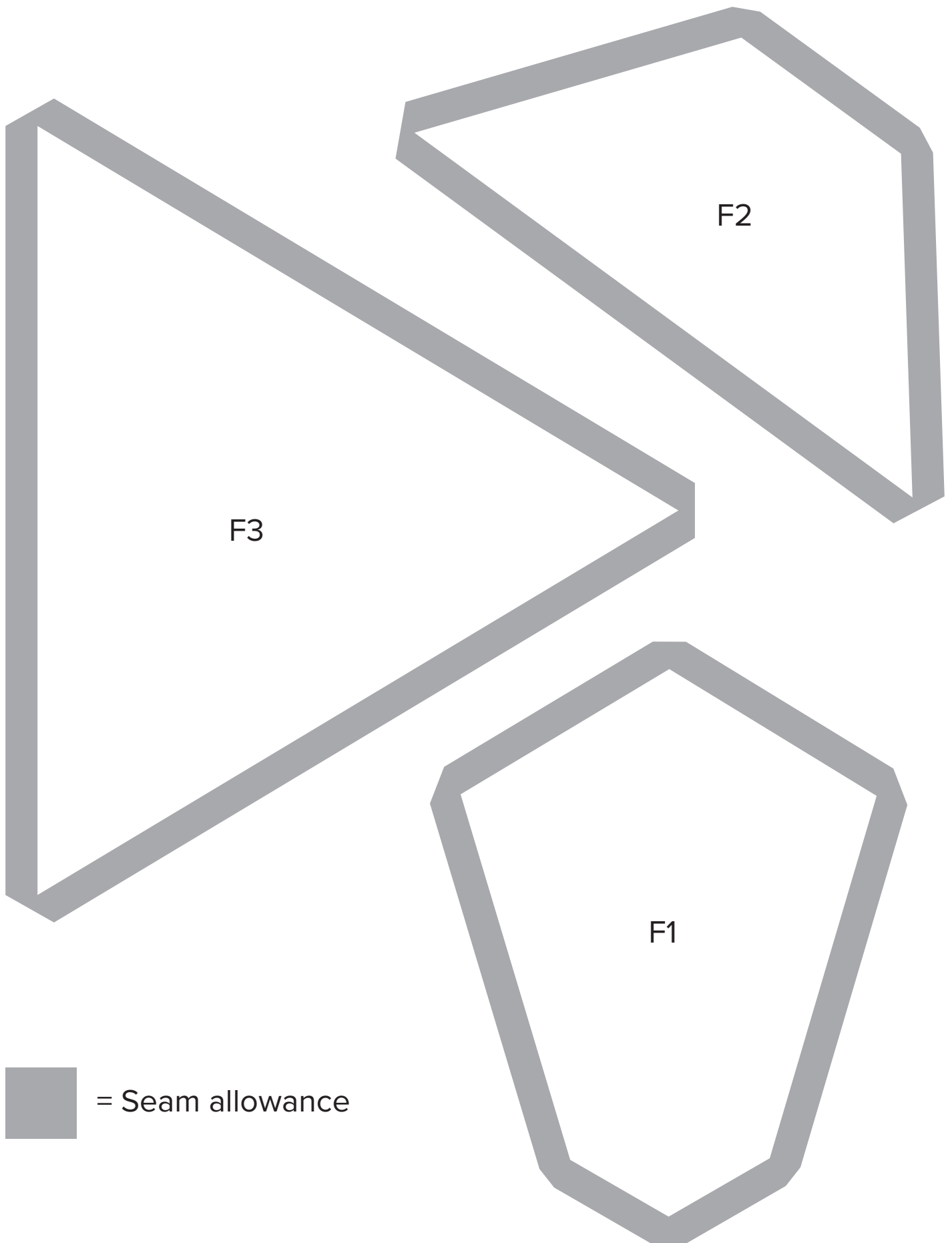
38Join 3½"x WOF strips in the following order: light grey, white, dark grey, grey, light grey, white dark grey, grey, light grey, white, dark grey. Trim to 29¼"x32"




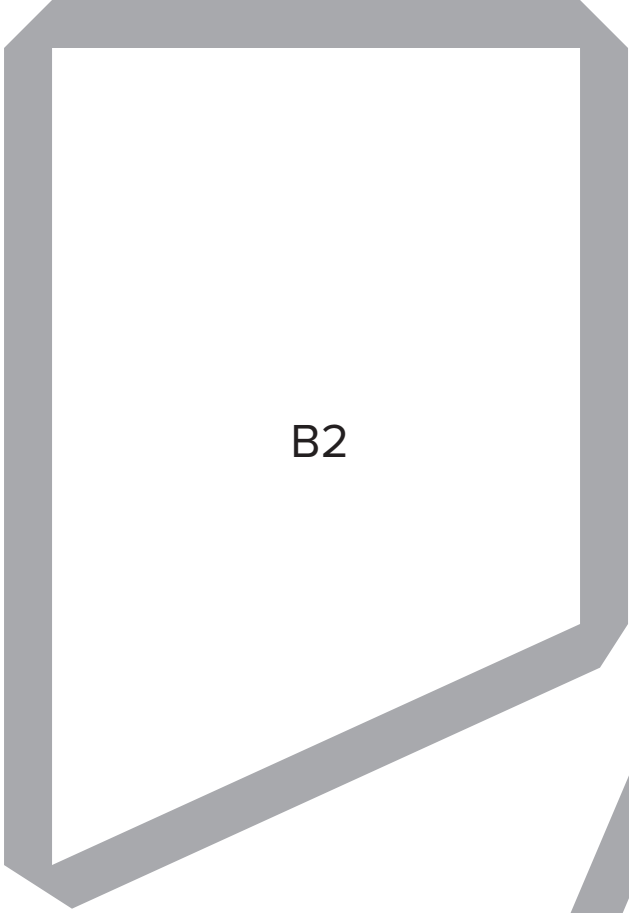
39Assemble units and borders using the assembly diagram on the following page.



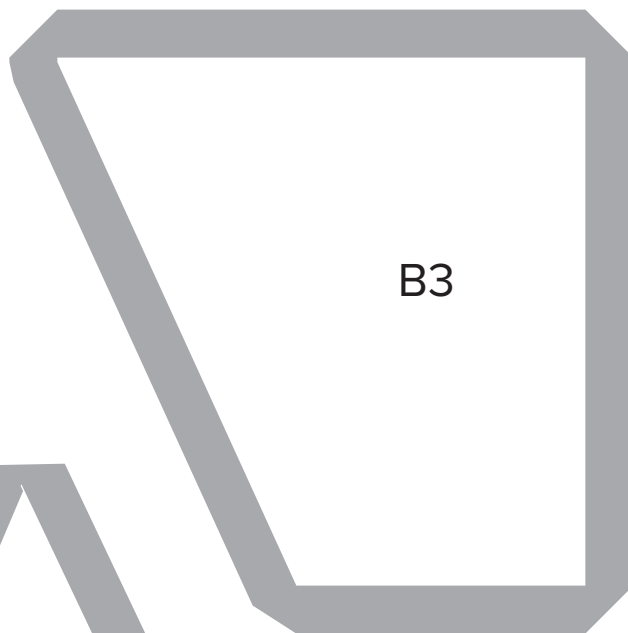
Assembly Diagram



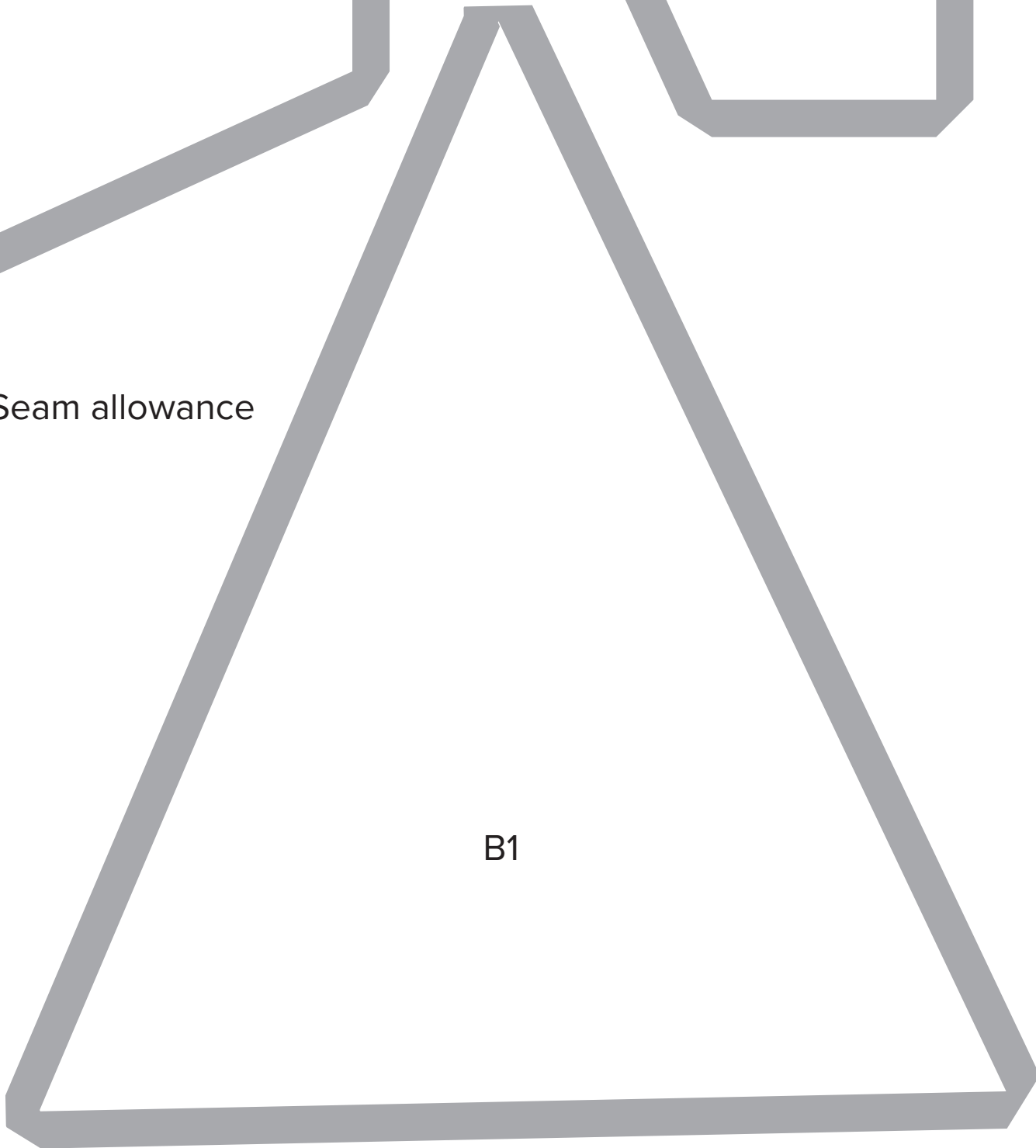
