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### Materials Requirements

- Assorted half yard cuts of Orange/ Halloween Fabrics or Fabric Scraps
  - Stuffing
    - Fat quarter green or brown
  - Assorted Colors of Embroidery Floss
    - Tapestry Needle
  - Templates (small, medium, and large)

### General Notes

- The finished sizes are small (5 inches), medium (8 inches), large (9 inches)
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4 inch unless specified
- Print templates on letter size (8.5" X 11") making sure to print on actual size or 100%

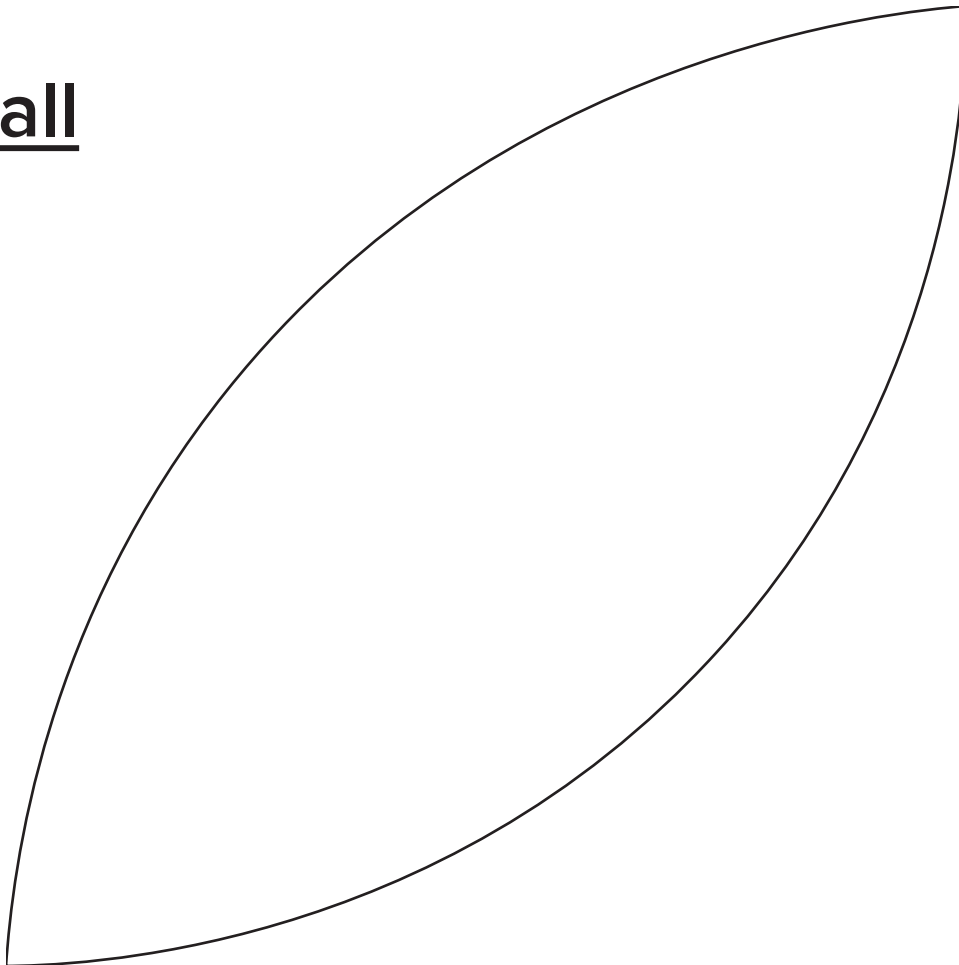
## Cut Your Fabric

- Pumpkin Body Fabric  
Trace and cut 6 pieces per pumpkin size
- Stem Fabric  
Cut two pieces per pumpkin size  
3" X 3" square for large  
2 1/2" X 2 1/2" for medium  
1 X 1" for small

## Piecing Instructions

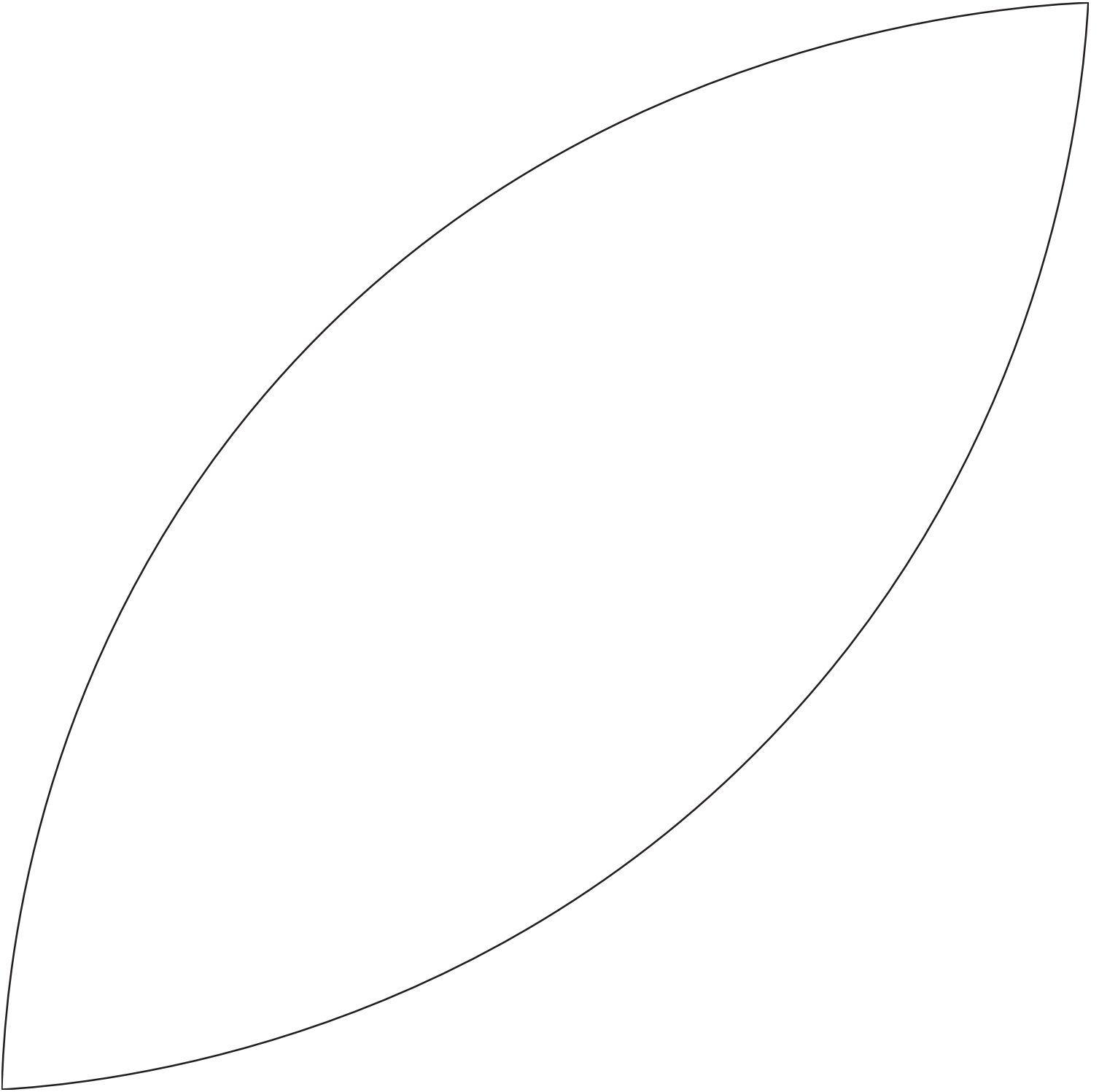
- 1 Trace templates onto pumpkin body fabric. Trace 6 per pumpkin
- 2 Cut out out pieces
- 3 Take two and place right sides together and sew on one side
- 4 Continue until you have three pairs
- 5 Take two pairs and put right sides together and sew
- 6 Continue until round
- 7 On the last seam leave a 1 1/2" gap
- 8 Turn right side out
- 9 Stuff with stuffing
- 10 Hand sew opening closed
- 11 Thread embroidery floss through ball to get a pumpkin shape
- 12 Cut out two stem squares per pumpkin
- 13 Sew on three sides leaving a gap at the bottom
- 14 Turn inside out
- 15 Stuff and hand sew to your pumpkin
- 16 If desired add embroidery floss or patch decorations
