Roof - ¼ yard

white – ½ yard window

Reds – 1/8-yard door and chimney

Tree – 4 fat quarters assorted colors

Trunk - 1/8-yard

Leaves - 3 fat quarters assorted colors

Stem - use tree trunk fabric color

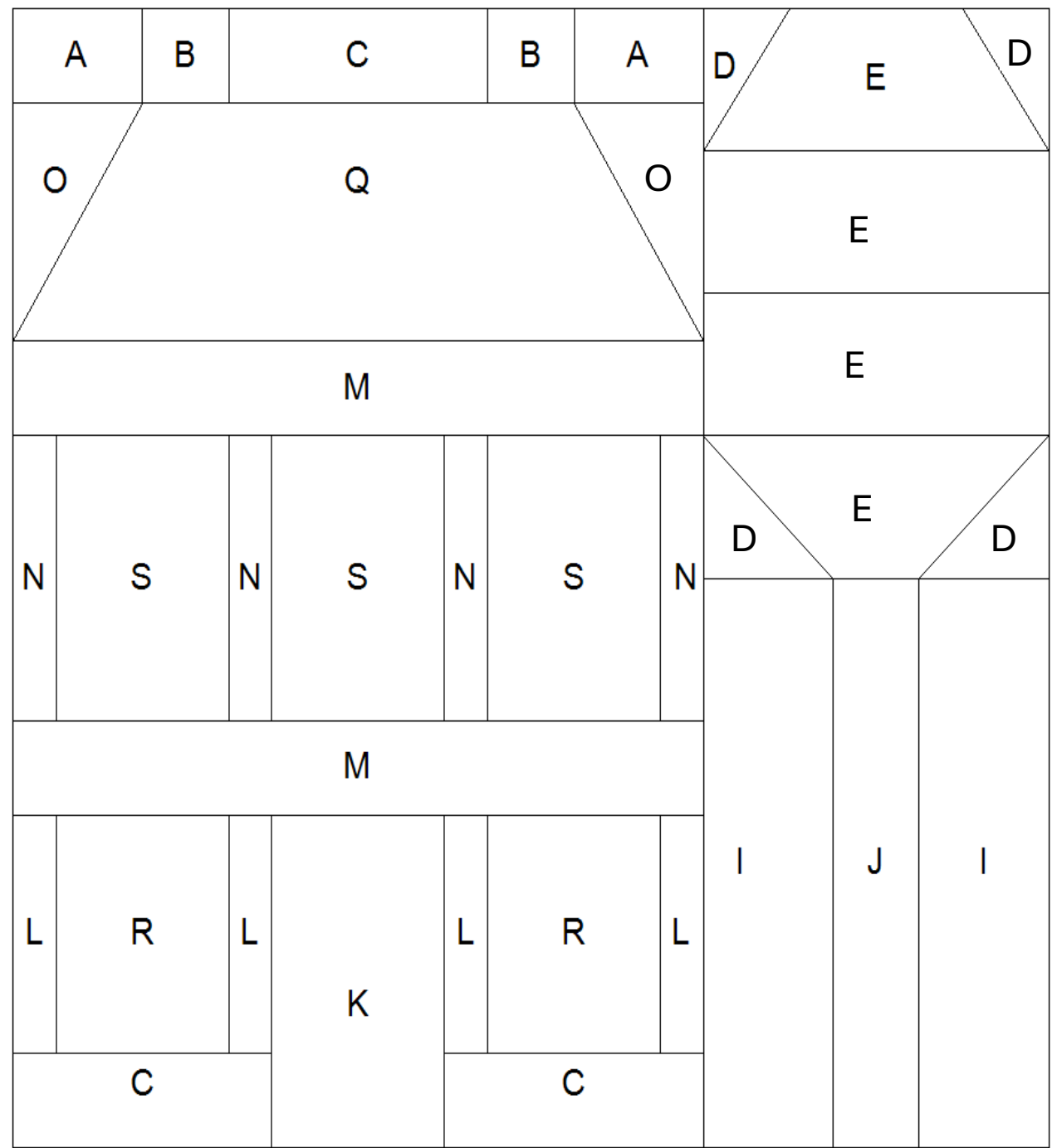
Borders- Inner use white fabric

Outer- 3/8" yard

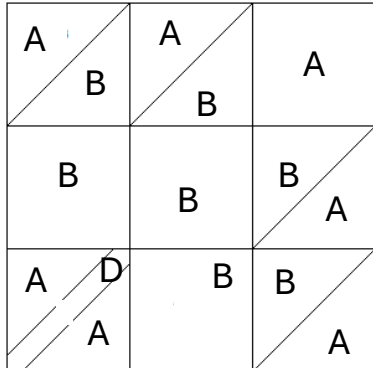
Backing 1 yard

Batting 1 yard





- Chimney – A – Cut 2 - white outer - 2”X 2 ¾” rectangle (assembly page)
- B – Cut 2 - dark red - 2” X 2” square
- C – Cut 1- white center - 2”X 5” rectangle
- Roof - O – Cut 2 - white outer roof use template (pages)
- Q - Cut 1- roof center use template (Pages) House:
- House - M - Cut 2 - house fabric -12 3/8” X 2” rectangles (pages)
- N - Cut 4 - house fabric - 1 1/4” X 5” rectangles.
- L - Cut 4 - house fabric - 1 ¼” X 4 1/8” rectangles.
- C - Cut 2 - house fabric - 2” X 5” rectangles.
- Windows S - Cut 3 - window fabric – 3.5” X 5” rectangle (pages)
- R - Cut 2 - window fabric - 3.5” X 4 1/8” rectangle.
- Door K - Cut 1 - door fabric - 3.5” X 5 5/8” rectangle.
- Tree Top E- Cut 4 - assorted treetop colors - 2 ¾” X 6.5” rectangles
- D- Cut 4 - whit fabric - 2 ¾” X 2 ¾” squares
- Tree trunk I - Cut 2 - white fabric – 2 ¾” X 9 3/8” rectangles
- J - Cut 1- brown trunk - 2” X 9 3/8” rectangle
- Leaves A - Cut 21 white fabric - 2.5 X 2.5” squares
- B - Cut 7 leaf fabric in each color - 2.5” X 2.5” squares
- C - Cut 3 - stem fabric 2.5” X 2.5” squares for the stems



House Block: Roof

Cutting Instructions

If fabric is wrinkled, please iron for cutting straighter cuts.

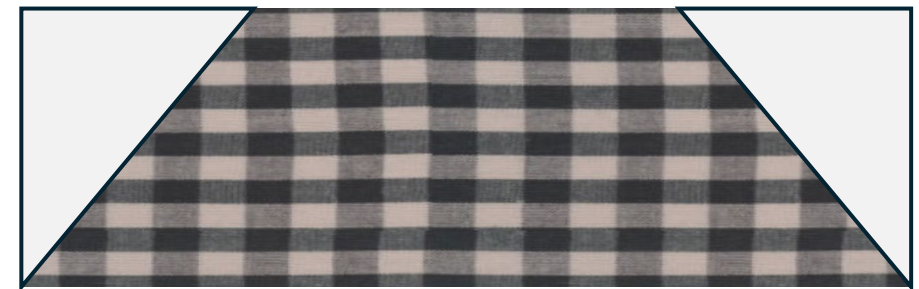
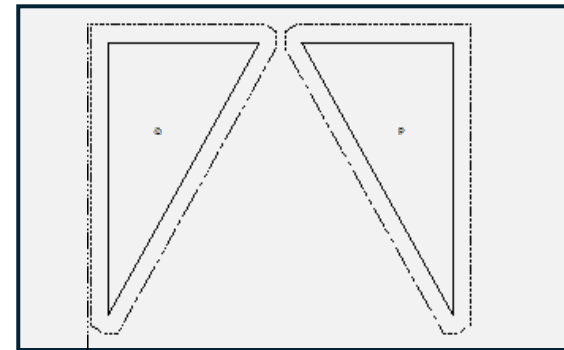
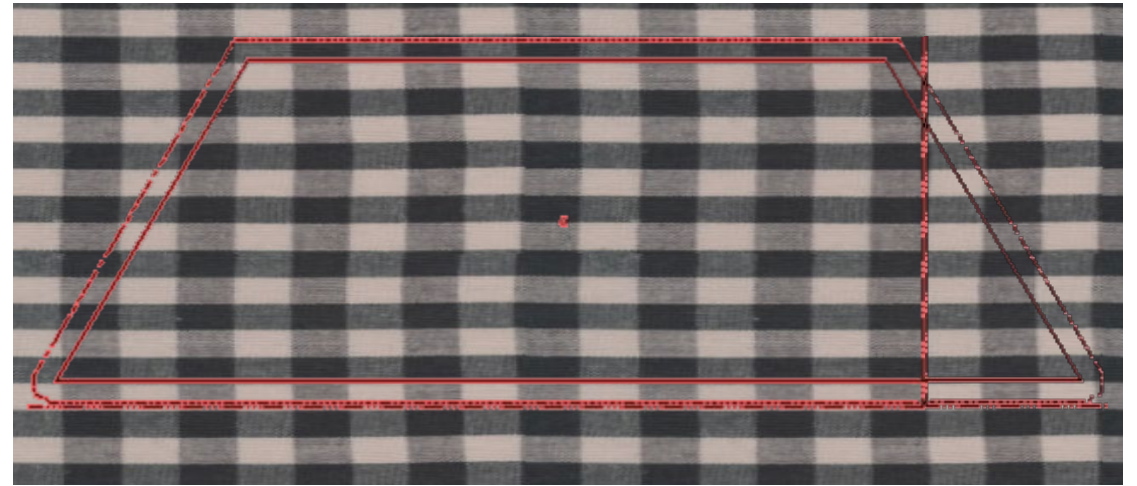
Use the templates provided for the roof and roof sides. To make the template roof the size needed you will need to tape the two parts together.

The two sides but two with right sides together this will make a right and left side piece.

Place template on fabric choice and use the flat pins to hold in place then cut around using either your rotary cutter or scissors.

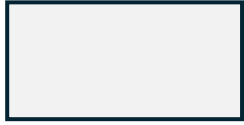
Sides lay the template on the white fabric and cut with right sides together pin to hold the template into place then cut.

Sew the right and left side pieces using $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance to the roof fabric and iron.

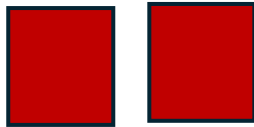




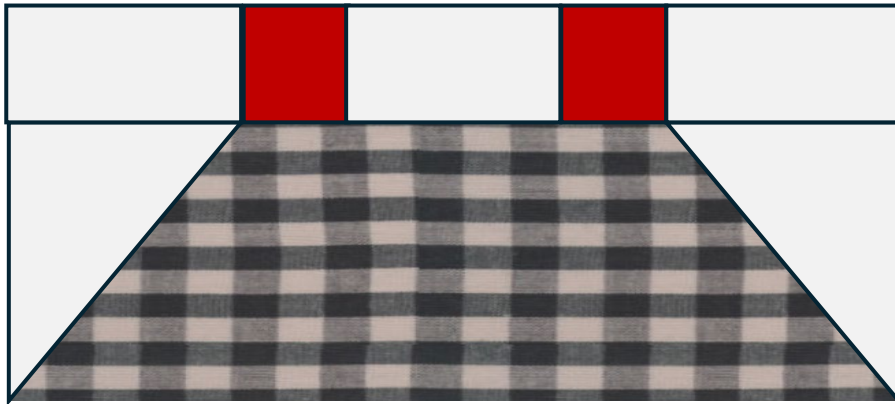
Center white:
Cut 1 white 2"X 5" rectangle.



Outer sides:
Cut 2 white 2"X 2 3/4"
rectangles.



Red Chimney's
cut two 2 X 2-inch squares



Sewing one outer edge to one chimney then
sew center. Sew to rooftop and iron.

Windows:

Cut 3 - 3.5" X 5" rectangle.

Cut 2 - 3.5" X 4 1/8" rectangle.

Door:

Cut 1 - 3.5" X 5 5/8" rectangle.

House:

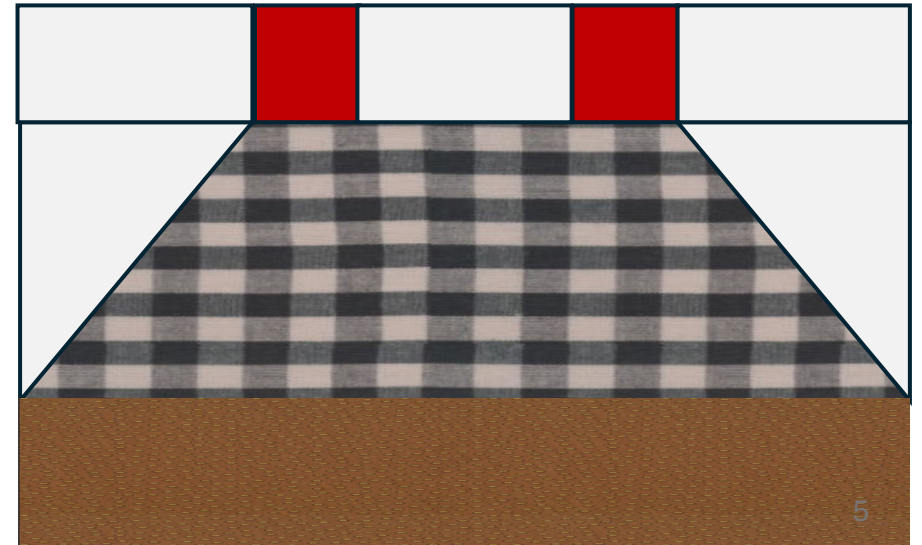
Cut 2 - 12 3/8" X 2" rectangles.

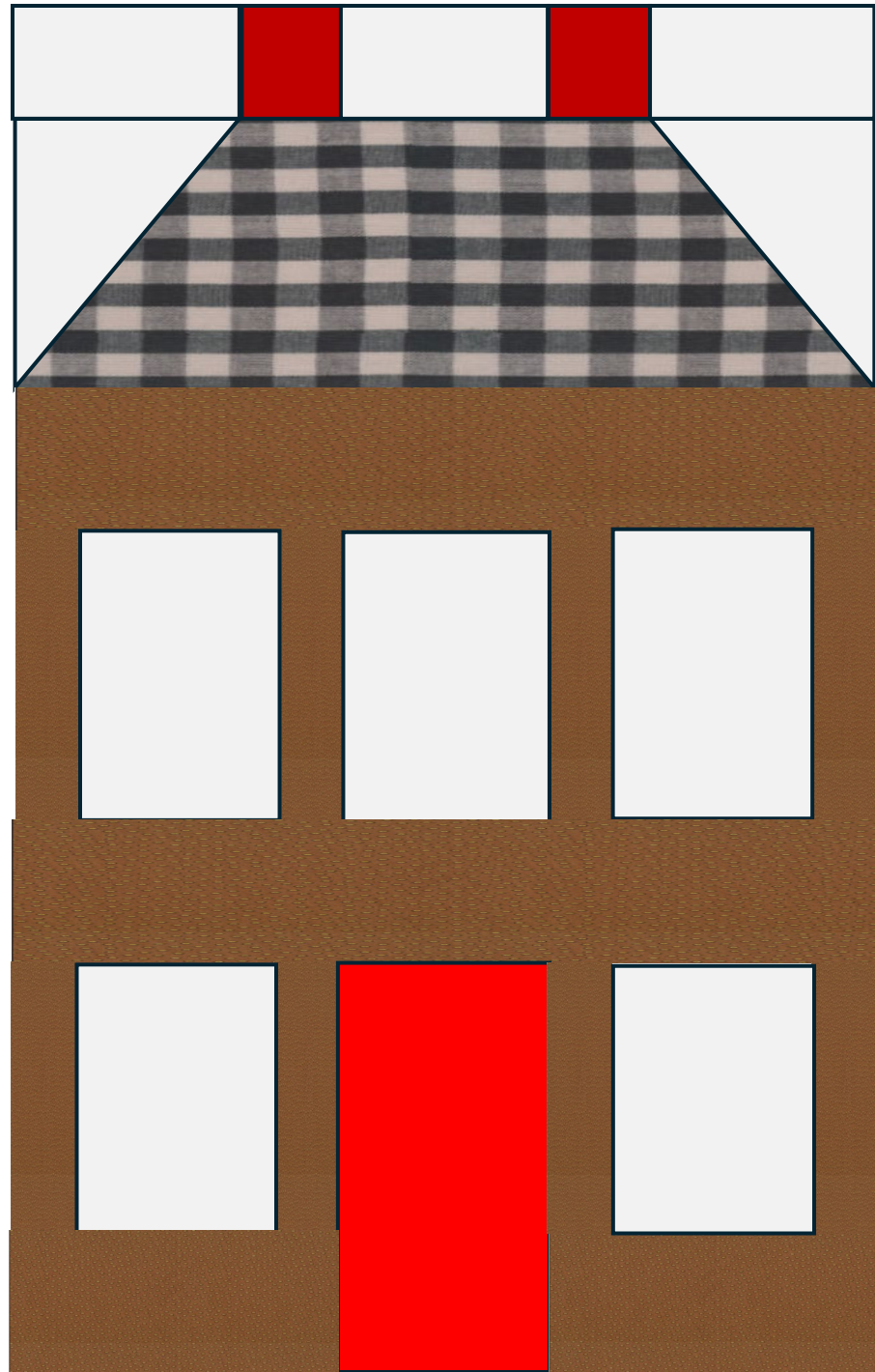
Cut 4 - 1 1/4" X 5" rectangles.

Cut 4 - 1 1/4" X 4 1/8" rectangles.

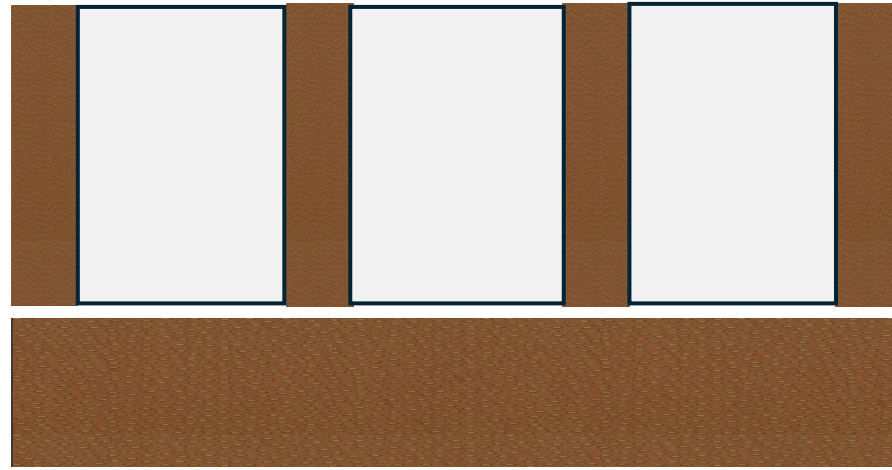
Cut 2 - 2" X 5" rectangles.

Assemble: Sew one long 12 3/8" rectangles to the bottom of the
roof and iron.

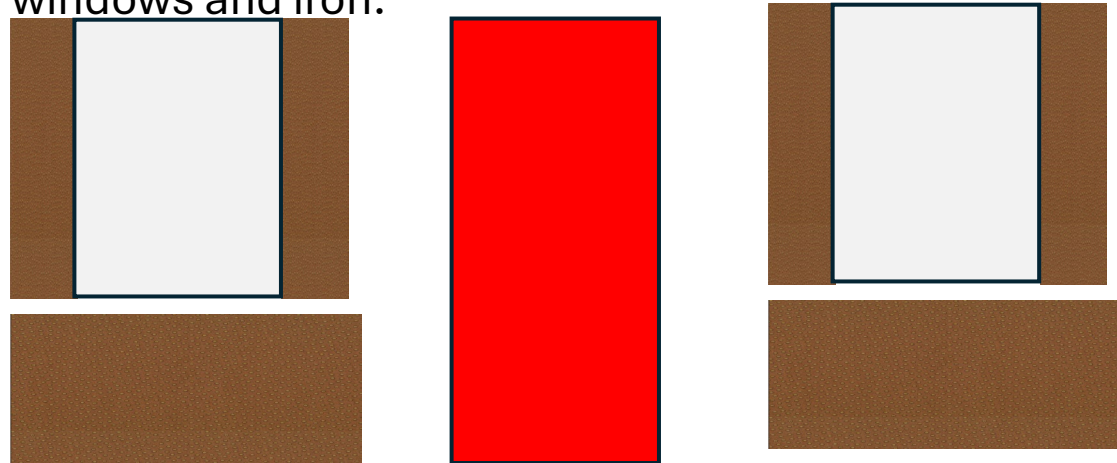




Sew $1\frac{1}{4}$ " X 5" rectangles to the large windows iron.



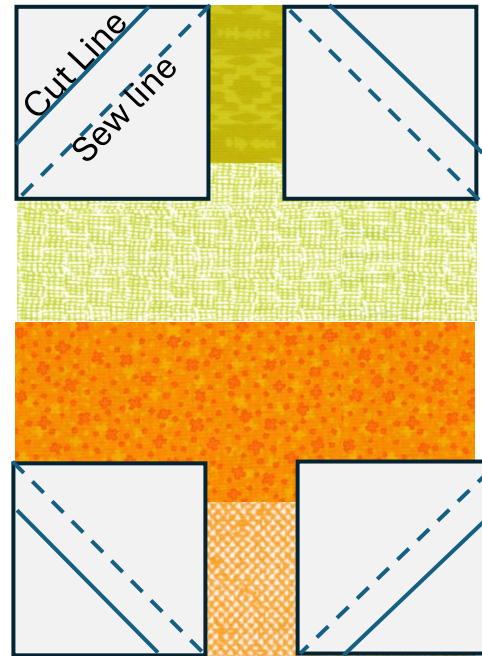
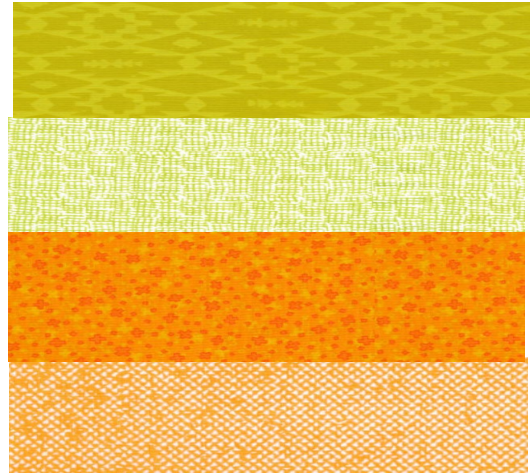
Sew $12\frac{3}{8}$ " X 2" rectangles to the bottom edge of the large windows and iron.



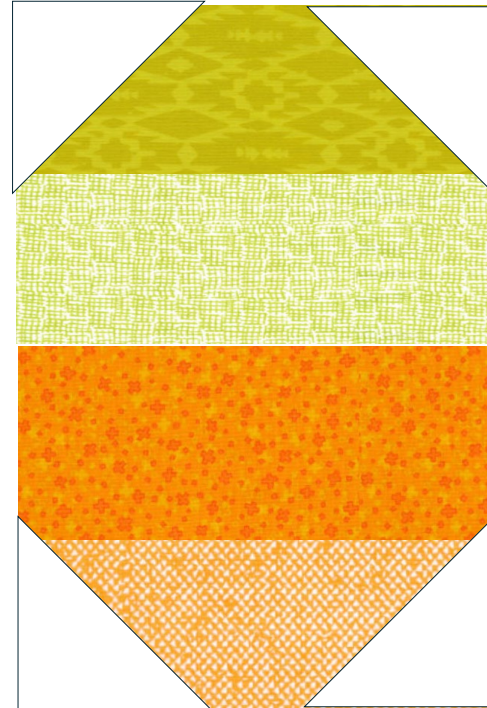
Sew $1\frac{1}{4}$ " X $4\frac{1}{8}$ " rectangles small window then sew bottom edge of window 2" X 5" strip and iron and repeat to other side. Sew door in the middle of the windows and iron. Sew bottom of house on to complete the house.

Tree:

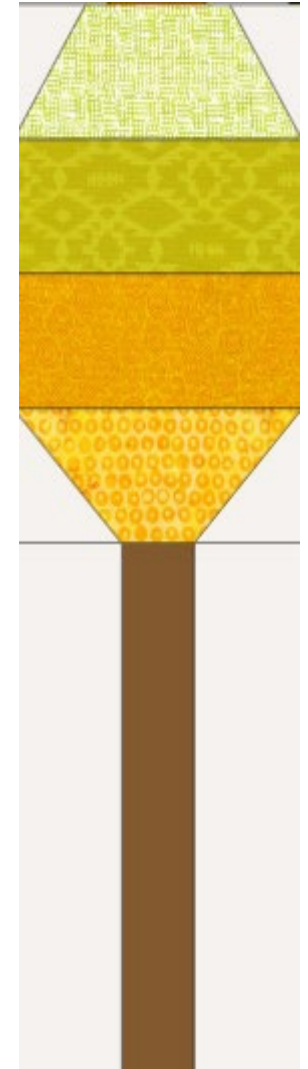
Cut 4 strips from your assorted colors
2 3/4" X 6.5" rectangles sew together
and square up.

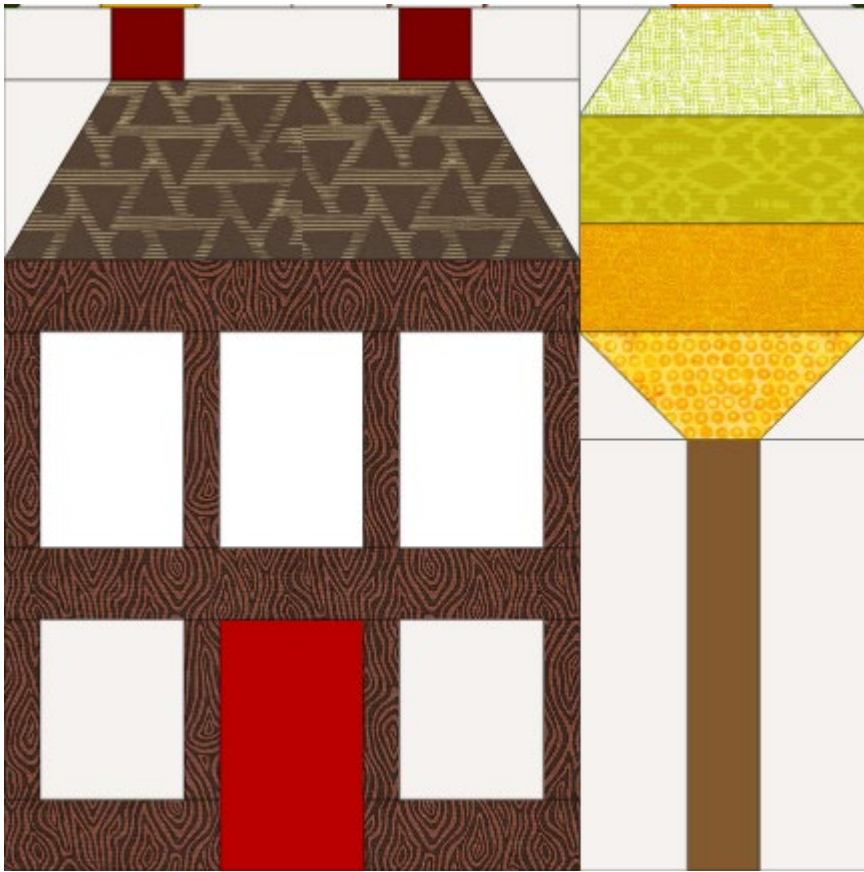


Cut 4 squares 2 3/4" X 2 3/4" fold to
made a diagonal crease and sew
along the diagonal. Cut off and iron.

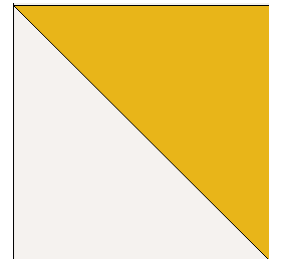
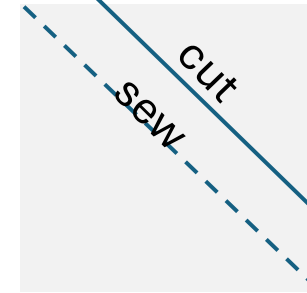
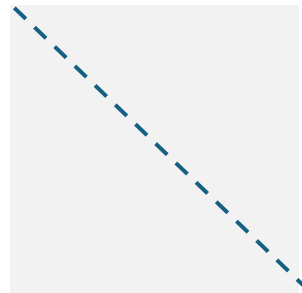
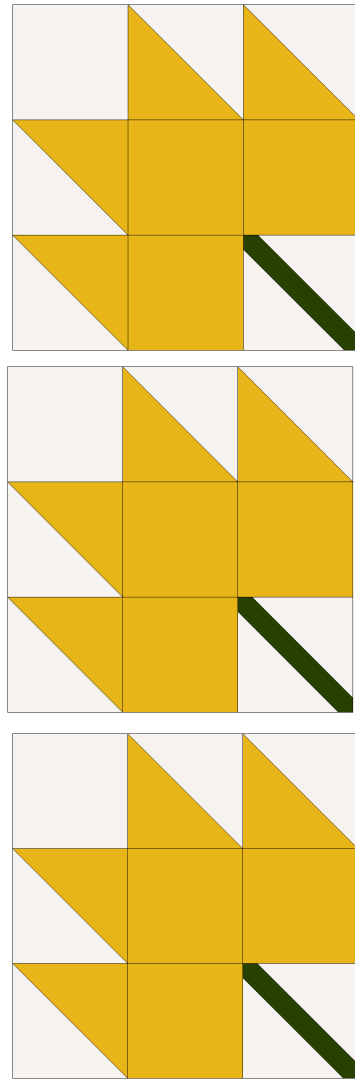


Cut 2 – 2 3/4" X 9 3/8" white rectangles
Cut 1 – 2" X 9 3/8" brown tree trunk.
Sew one white strip to the brown trunk
and sew the 2nd strip to the other side
and iron.





You have completed the house and tree quilt block. It should be 18" X 18" square.

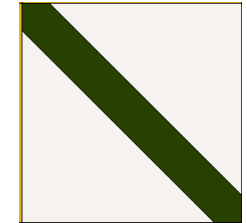
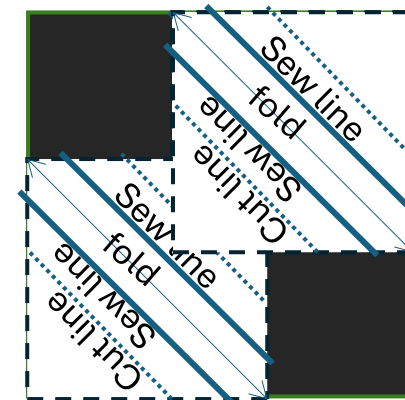


Cut 21- 2.5 X 2.5" white squares
 Cut 7- 2.5" X 2.5" squares for 3 different colors for the leaves.
 Cut 3 - 2.5" X 2.5" squares for the stems.

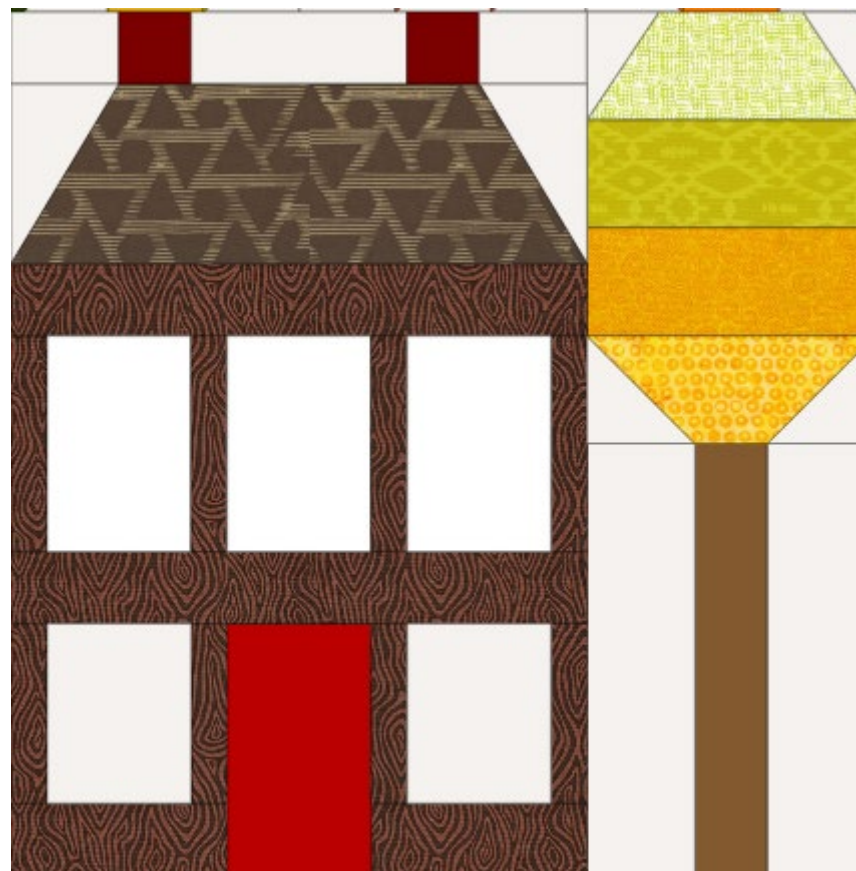
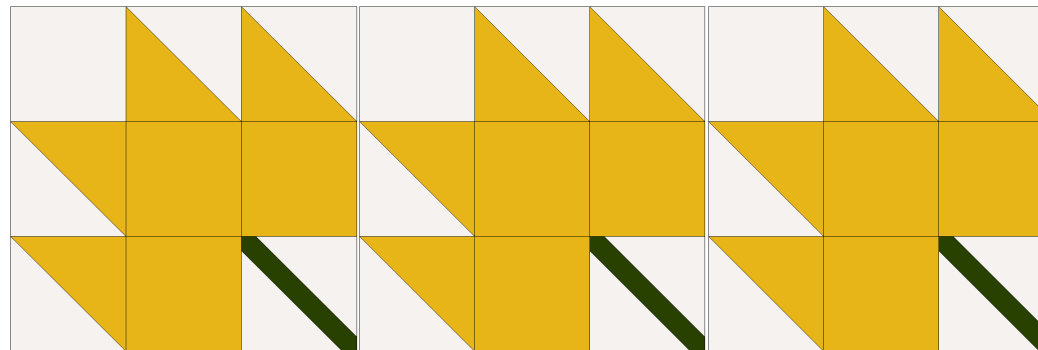
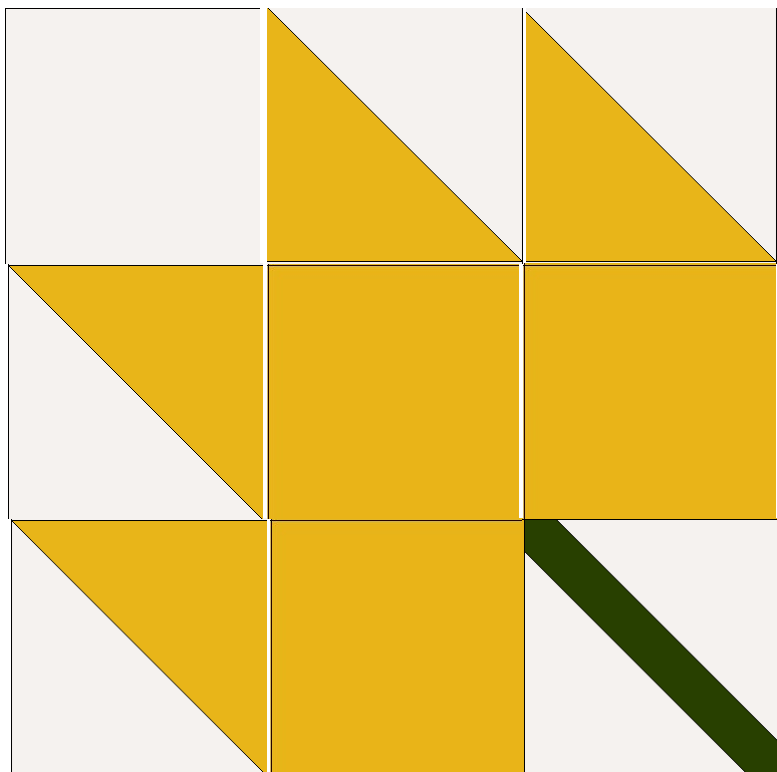
Fold 18 white triangles in half to get a diagonal line or use pencil to draw.

Assembly instructions leaves.

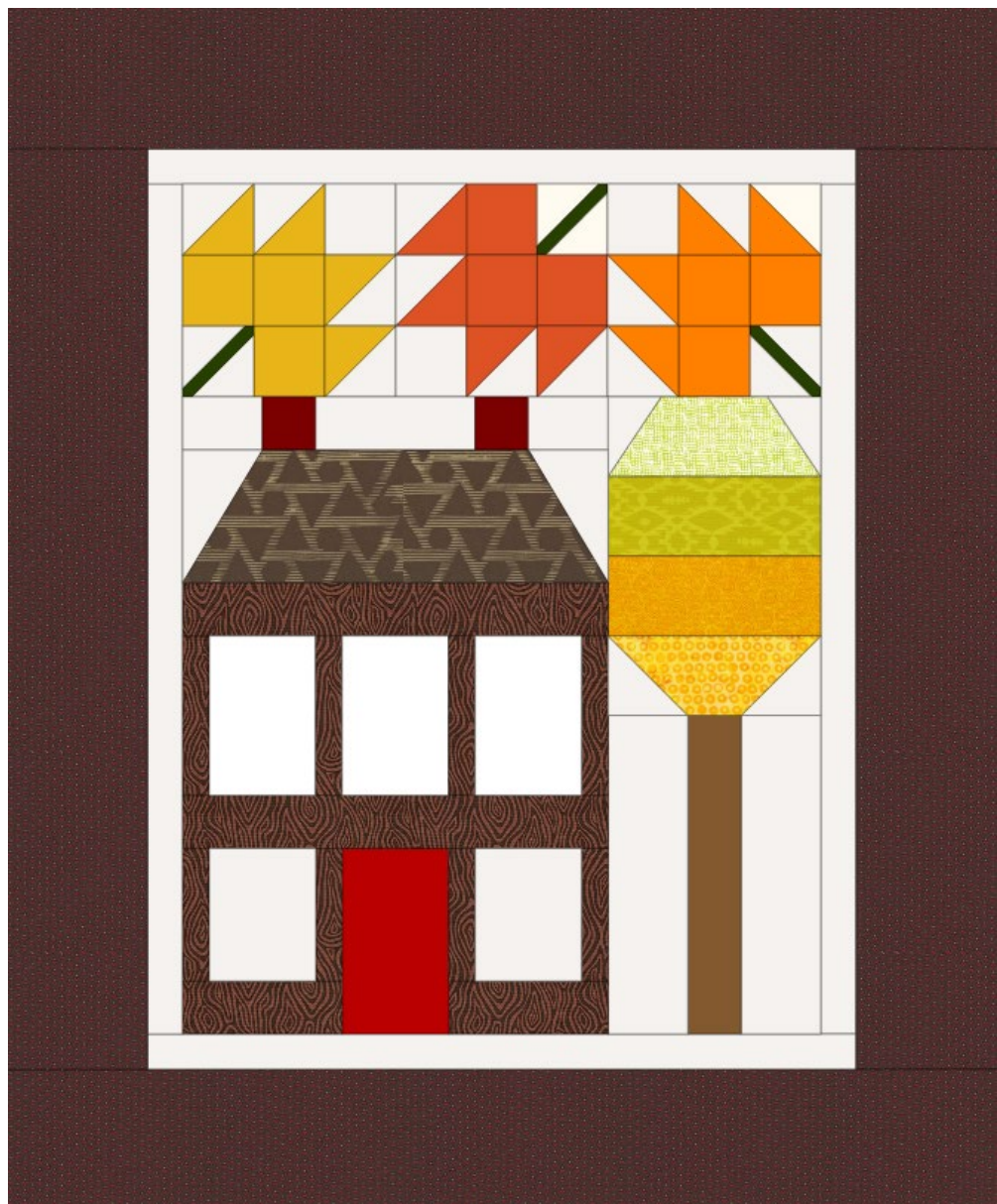
Stem: place one white square on top and sew to the right of the folded line. Cut off the excess and sew the other side and this time sew to the left. Cut off excess and iron.



Use 4 of the folded triangles and place on 4 of each colored squares for the leaf and sew down the diagonal line then cut use a 1/4 cut from sew line and iron.



Sew leaves together and sew to the top of the house and iron. Complete by cutting 4- 1.5" white by 30 inches and sew for inner border. Complete by cutting 4 - 2.5" by 32" outer borders then iron and quilt.



Inner Border: Cut 4 -1 ½" X WOF sew sides first then cut off excess, sew top and bottom and cut off the excess.

Outer Border: Cut 4- 3" X WOF strips sew sides first cut off excess then sew top, and bottom strips and once again cut off excess.

Now it is time to quilt cut your backing and batting 8" wider and longer than your quilt top and quilt. For just a small fall wall hanging

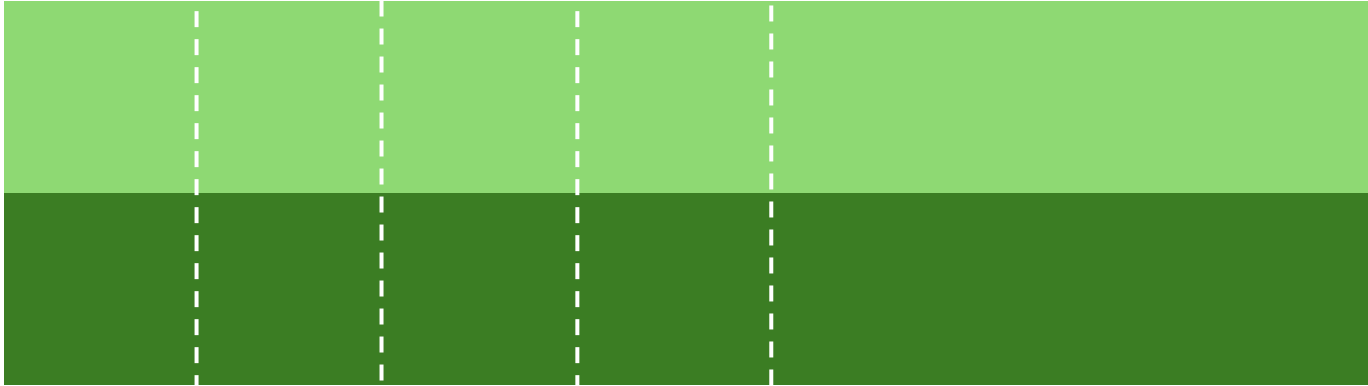


Grass: Cut 1- light green 2 ½” strip

Cut 1- dark green 2out ½” strip

Sew the two strips together and cut 9 – 2 ½” X 4 ½” pieces. Sew together alternating the greens.

Sew the grass strip to the bottom of the house and you have completed the house block.



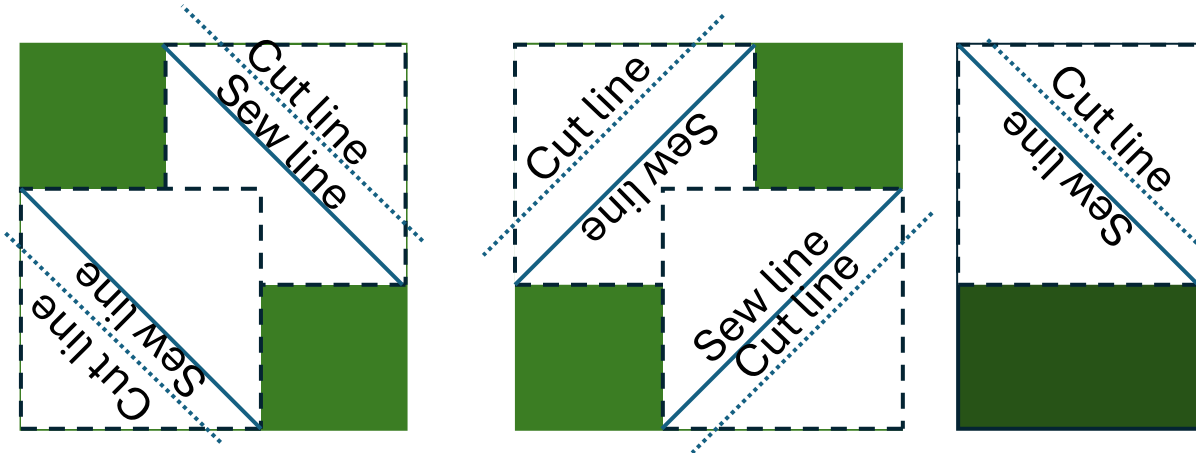
Pumpkin Block:

Cut:

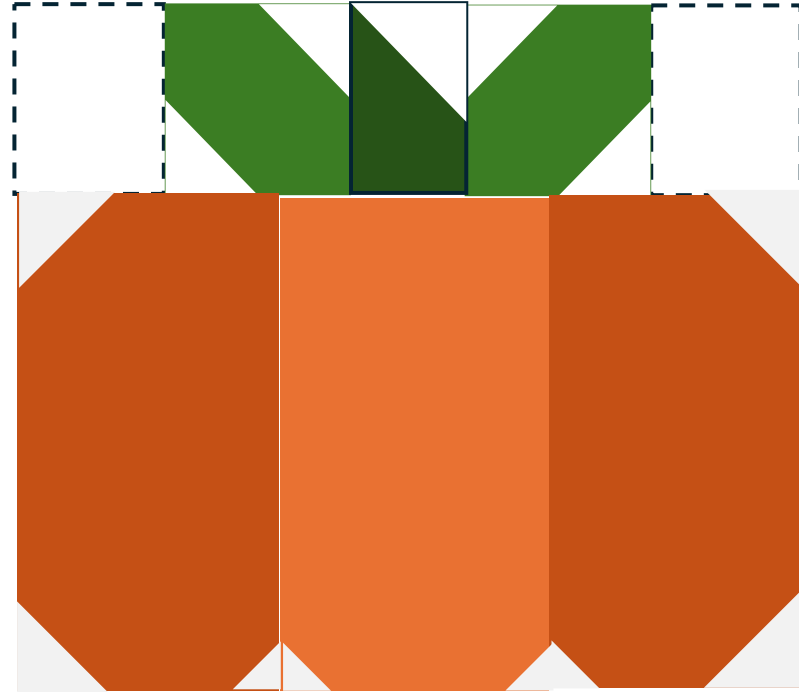
- 2 - white rectangles 1 5/8" wide X 2" long.
- 2 - green leaves 2" X 2" square.
- 1 - green stem 1 1/4" wide X 2" long.
- 4 - white 1" squares.
- 9 - white 1 1/4" squares.
- 2 - dark orange 2 1/2" wide X 5" long rectangle.
- 1 - light orange 2 1/2" wide X 5" long rectangle.

Sew triangles to each of the following shapes to make half square triangles.

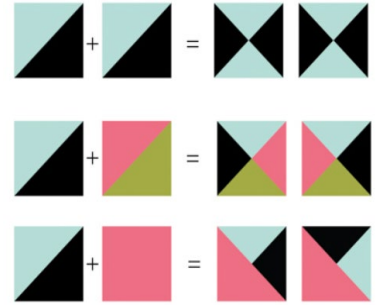
Leaves and Stem: use the 5 - 1 1/4" either fold or mark squares using a pencil to make a diagonal sewing line and place on the top left and bottom right for right side leaf. For the left leaf place one square on the top right and bottom left corners, sew on the sewing line then cut use a 1/4" from the sewing line to cut. The stem is the same process place at the top of the stem the diagonal sew line is at the top left corner then sew and cut. Once you have completed all the triangles sew together the top of the pumpkin.



For the body of the pumpkin take the 2 1/2" X 5" dark orange strips place on one a white 1 1/4" square on the top left corner and the bottom left corner. For the left side bottom right corner use the smaller 1" square. For the right side you will place on square on the top right corner and bottom right and use a 1" square for the bottom left corner shown below. Then sew your strips together make sure that you light orange is in the middle of the two dark pieces.

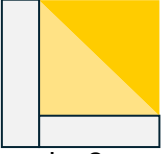
Start with two half square triangle units.
 Yields 2 finished quarter-square triangle units.
 Seam allowance = 1/4in.

Sunflower Block:
 Cut 1- Brown 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" square for middle.



Cut 4- Yellow 1 7/8" X 1 7/8" squares.
 Cut 4- Gold 1 7/8" X 1 7/8" squares.
 Cut 4- White 1 7/8 X 1 1/2" strip.
 Cut 4- White 1 7/8" X 2" strip

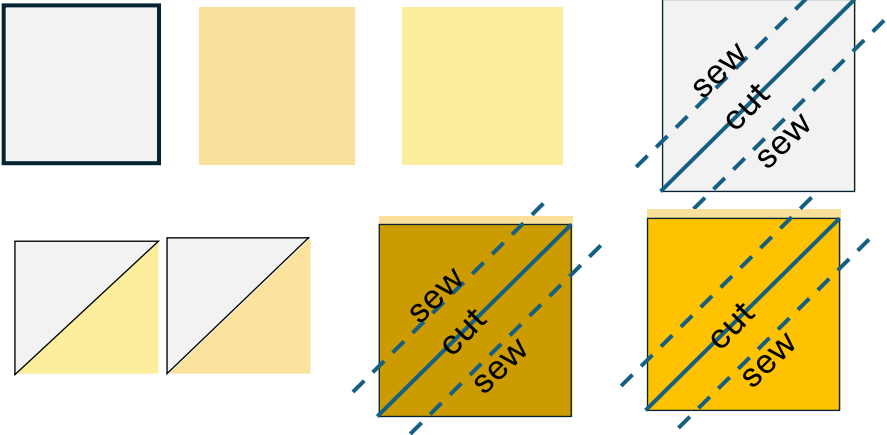
Sew 1 yellow 1 gold right side together and fold sew on fold and cut to make your half square triangle. Sew the 1 7/8" X 1 1/2" white to the lighter triangle edge, see below. Next sew the 1 7/8" X 2" white strip to the top and lay out the four corner squares.



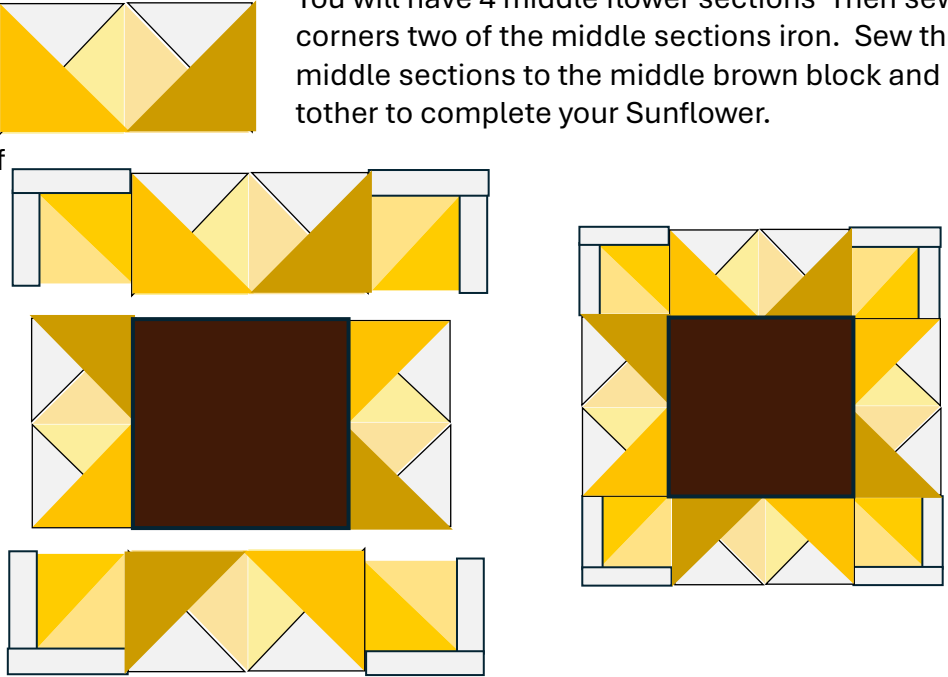
Using the formula chart to the right, make 2 sets of quarter square triangles.

Cut 4- white 3 1/4" squares
 Cut 2 - light gold 3 1/4" squares
 Cut 2 - med gold 3 1/4" squares
 Cut 2 - dark gold 3 1/4" squares
 Cut 2- dark bright yellow 3 1/4" squares

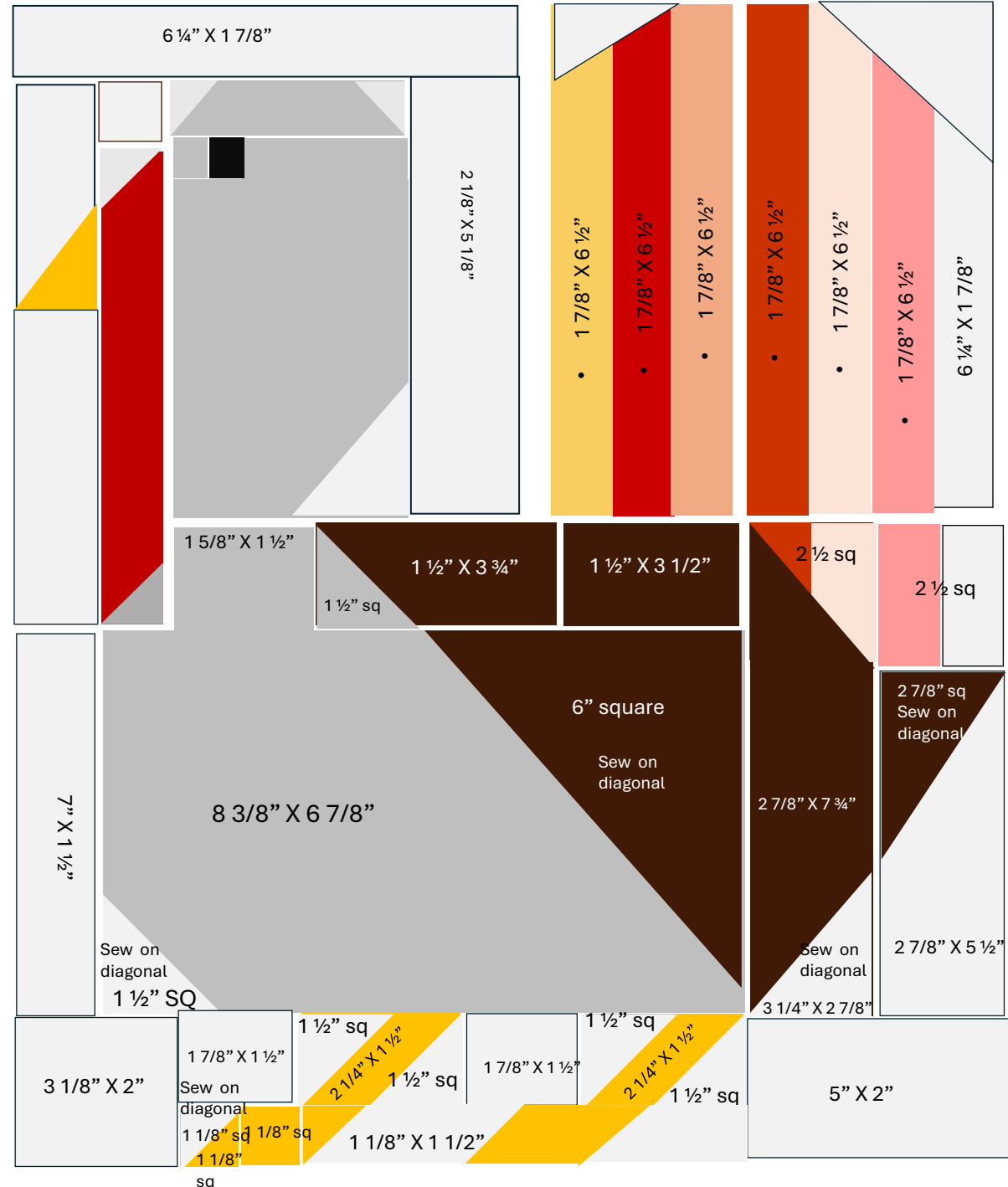
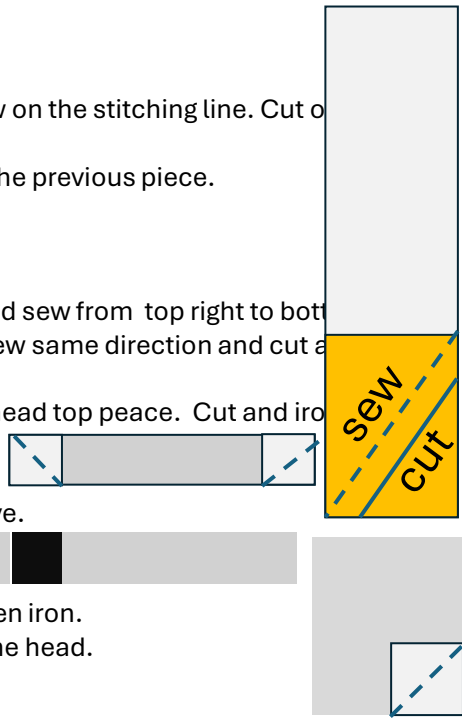
Take 4 white squares and place the gold or yellow of your choice Draw a line from top right to bottom left corner and sew on each side of the sewing line. Cut directly on the fold to make 2 half square triangles. You will have a total of 4 with the two different colors.

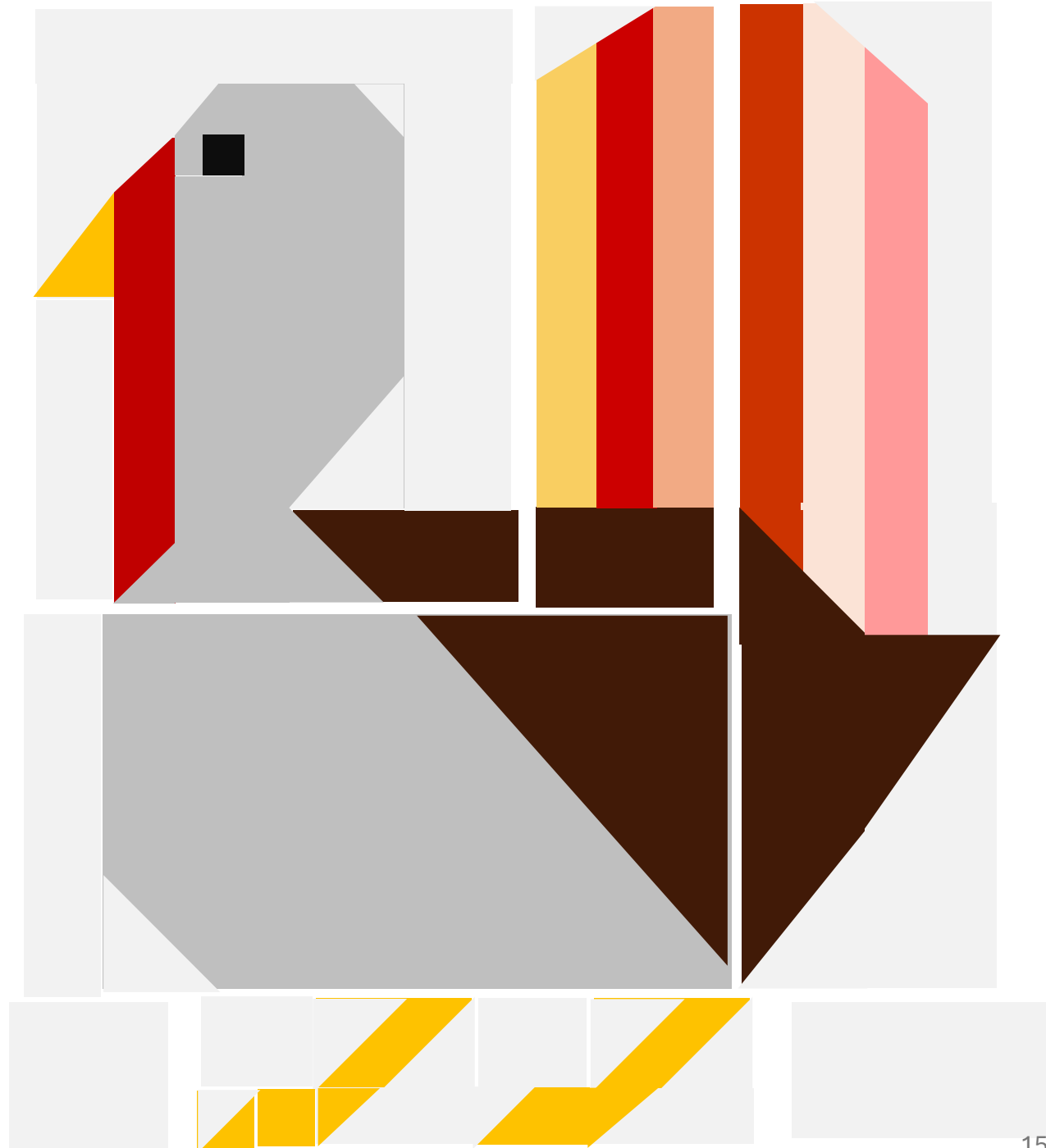


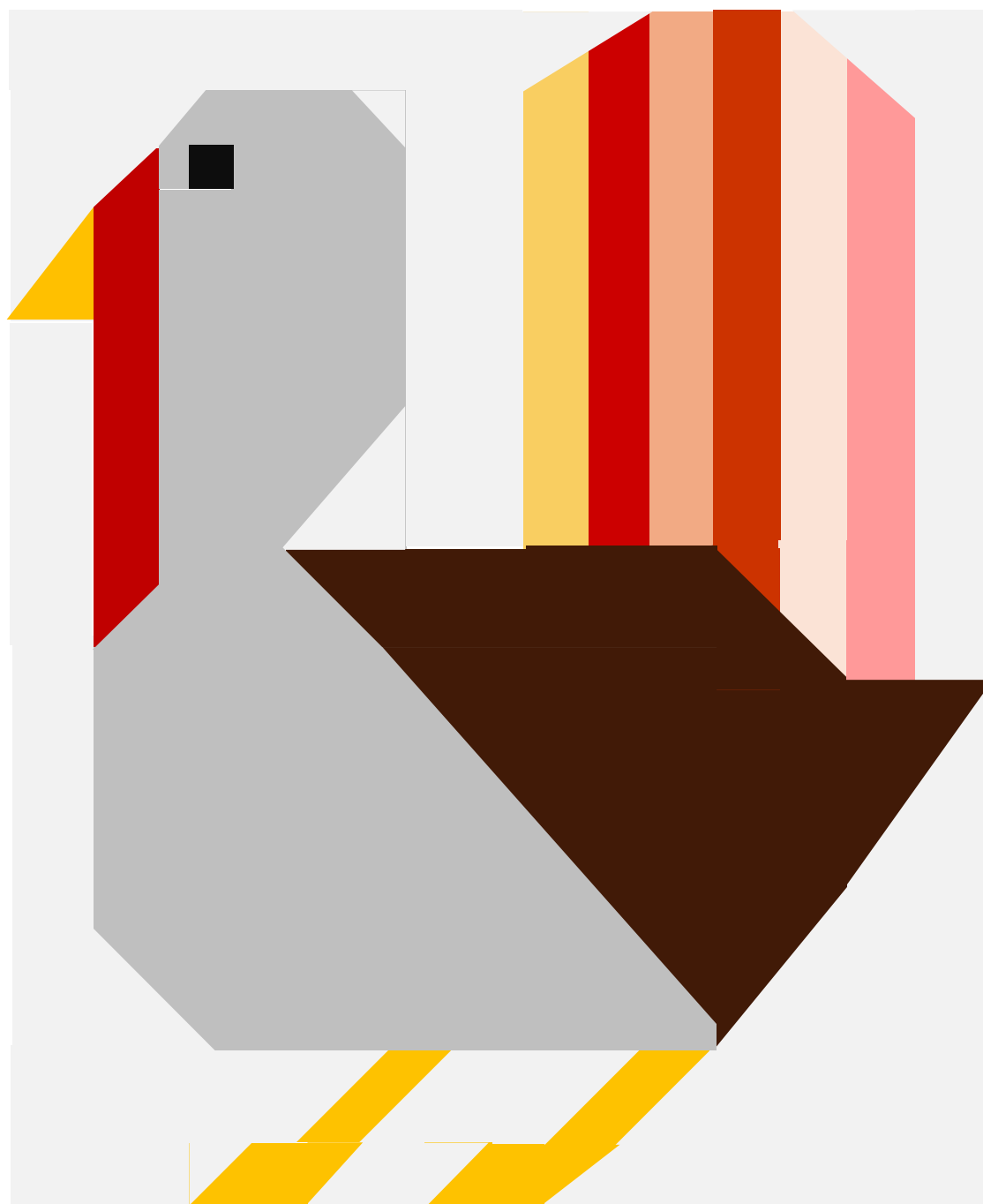
Sew together the two middle flower sections together and iron. You will have 4 middle flower sections Then sew the two corners two of the middle sections iron. Sew the remaining middle sections to the middle brown block and sew the rows together to complete your Sunflower.

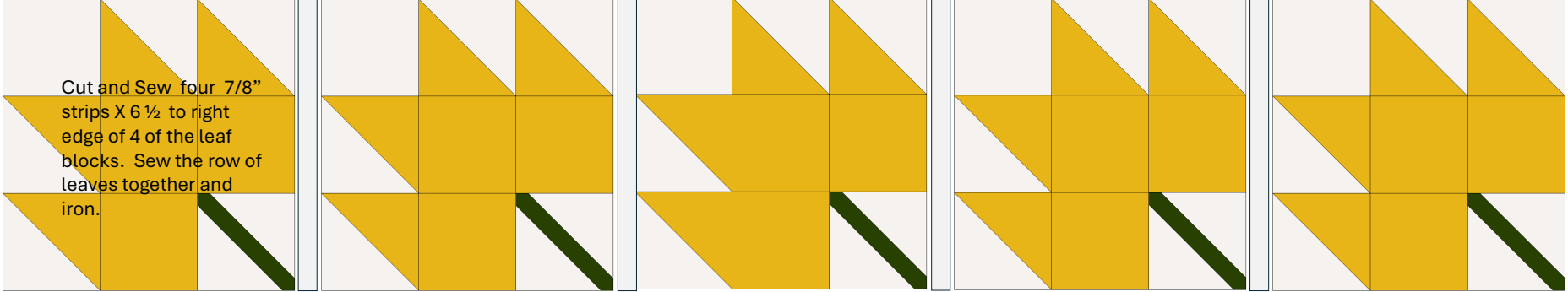


- Cut 1- white 1 3/8” X 3” rectangle
- Cut 1- gold beak 1 3/8” X 1 7/8” rectangle
- Fold the gold beak to make a diagonal stitching line and sew on the stitching line. Cut off excess.
- Cut 1 –white strip 1 3/8” X 9 7/8” and sew. to the bottom of the previous piece.
- Cut 1- red 1 1/8” X 5 7/8” rectangle strip.
- Cut 1 – tan 1 1/8” X 1 1/8” square.
- Cut 1 – white 1 1/8” X 1 1/8” square.
- Place the white square on the top and fold for sewing line and sew from top right to bottom and then cut. Place the tan square at the bottom fold and sew same direction and cut a
- Cut 1- tan or grey 3 1/4” X 1 1/8” for turkey head top.
- Cut 2 – white 1 1/8” squares and sew on both ends of your head top piece. Cut and iron
- Cut 1- black or dark brown 1 1/4” X 1 1/4” square for eye
- Cut 1 – tan or grey for head 1 1/4” X 1 1/8” for left side of eye.
- Cut 1 – tan or grey for head 1 1/4” X 2 1/4” for the right side of eye.
- Sew together and iron.
- Cut 1- tan or grey head 3 1/4” X 3 7/8”
- Cut 1- white 2 1/4” X 2 1/4” square for the bottom neck. Sew then iron.
- Cut 1- white 2 1/8” X 5 1/8” and sew down the right side of the head.
- Cut 1- tan or grey 1 5/8” X 1 1/2” for bottom of head or neck
- Cut 1- dark brown or grey for wing 1 1/2” X 3 3/4”
- Cut 1 – tan or grey square 1 1/2” X 1 1/2” and sew onto the left side of the wing iron and sew onto the bottom of the head
- Cut 1 white strip 6 1/4” X 1 7/8” sew to the top of the head piece
- Cut 6 strips for the tail 1 7/8” X 6 1/2” sew 2 sets of 3 together with additional the white strip to the 2nd group and iron.
- Cut 1 rectangle 2 1/4” X 1 3/4” place 2 1/4 side along the top left side of the 1st group of 3 tail feathers and sew a diagonal from top right to bottom left the open and iron cut.
- Cut 1 3 1/4” square place on the upper right corner of the 2nd group of tail feathers with the extra white strip and sew on a diagonal from top left to bottom right iron then cut.
- Sew the first group of 3 to the tail feathers left edge of the head and iron.
- Cut 1 brown or dark grey 1 1/2” X 3 1/2” strip sew then iron
- Sew the neck and upper wings to the head and tail feathers then sew the gobbler and beak to the head.
- Cut and sew rest following the diagram to the right. The legs are like the leaf stem you cut a rectangle the 2 1/4” X 1 1/2” the place a 1 1/2” square on the upper left sew on a diagonal from upper right corner to the bottom left. Place another 1 1/2” square on the bottom right and sew once again on a diagonal from the upper right to the bottom left and you have a leg. Repeat for the other.
- Cut and sew according to the diagram.



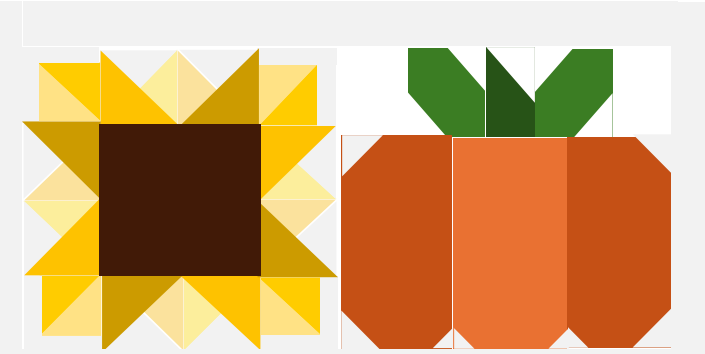




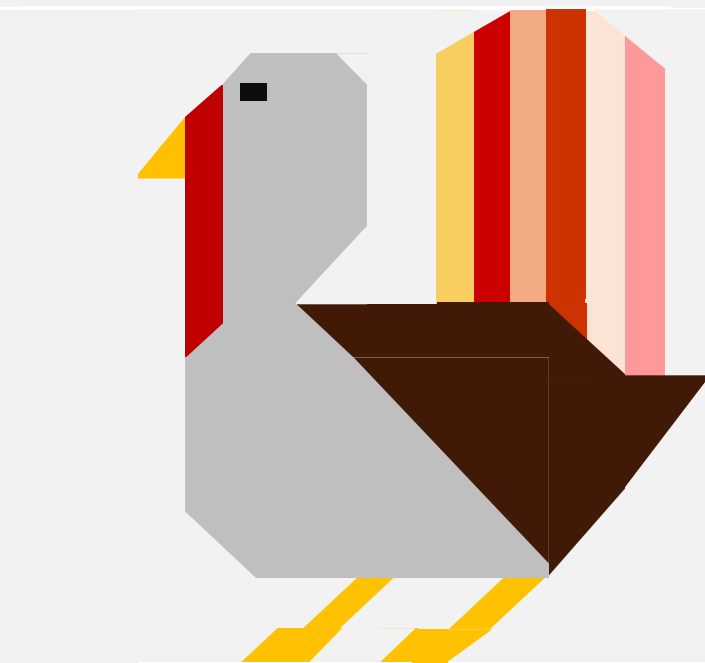


Cut and Sew four 7/8" strips X 6 1/2" to right edge of 4 of the leaf blocks. Sew the row of leaves together and iron.

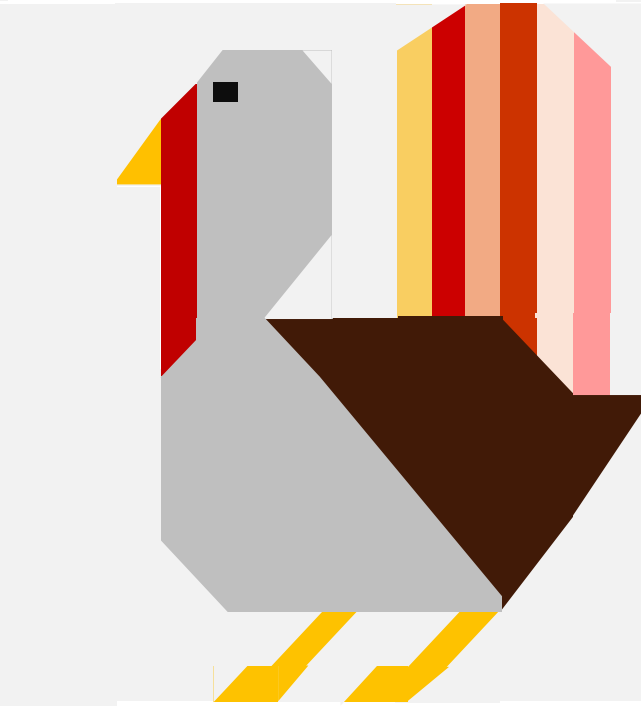
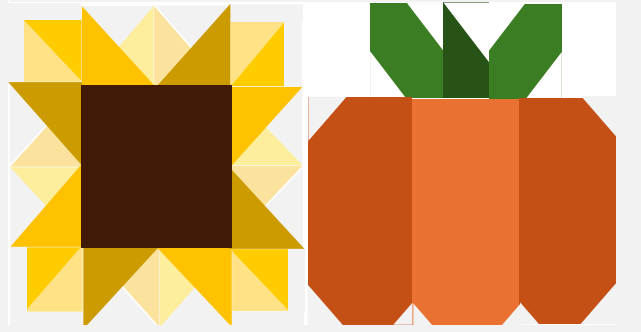
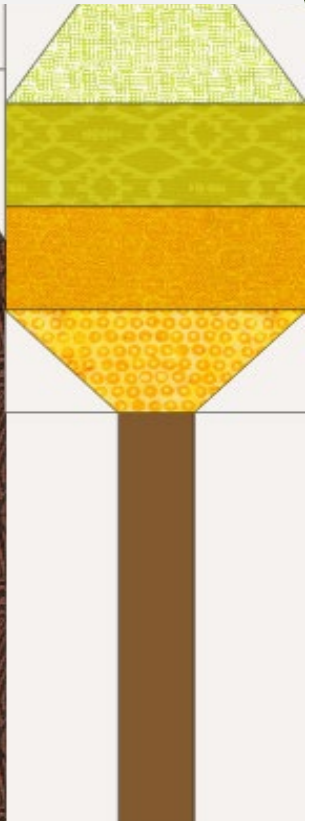
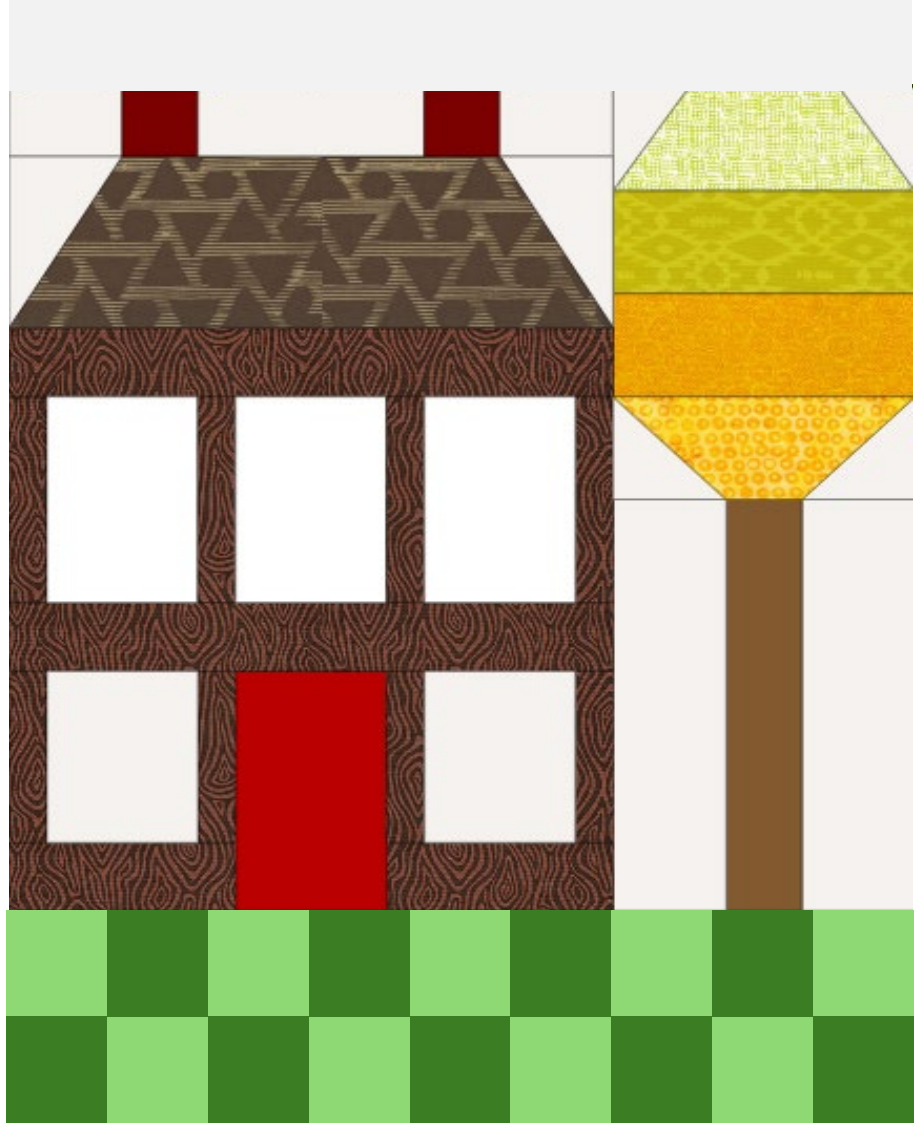
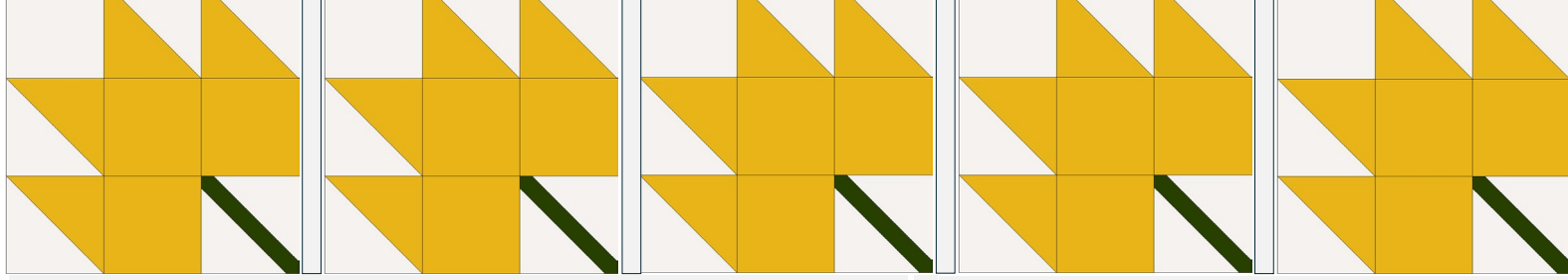
Cut & Sew a 2 7/8" X Width of house block strip to the top of the house cut and iron.



Cut 2 & Sew a 2 1/8" X 12 1/2" to the top and bottom of the sunflower and pumpkin block to the left and right sides cut 2 - 1 3/4" X 12 3/4" strips and iron.



Sew the Turkey to the bottom of the sunflower and pumpkin block and sew to the house and sew the row of leaves to the top.



Cut and sew a 1 ½” inner border to all four side then cut and sew a 3 ½” darker brown border. Quilt using your own style of creativity. And display for the holidays.
