

SCRAPPY NEEDLE BOOK



Fabric Requirements:

- Fabric scraps
- (2) Flannel Fat Quarters
- (2) Cotton Fat Quarters
- 13.5" x 10.5" foam stabilizer or Soft & Stable
- At least 20 x 26" of Batting
- (1) 13" x 10" Piece of Clear Vinyl

Additional Supplies:

- TrueCut Square Quilting Ruler
- TrueCut Comfort or StraightCut Cutter
- Coordinating Finesse Thread
- Fabric Scissors
- Erasable Fabric Marker

General Cutting:

From Flannel:

• (4) 10 x 12.5" Pieces

From Cotton Fat Quarters:

- (1) 11.5 x 14.5" Piece for Inside Front Cover
- (3) 2.5" Strips for Binding

From Clear Vinyl:

• (8) 1.5 x 4.25" Pieces

From Batting:

• (2) 9.75 x 12.5" Pieces

Pattern uses a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

Front Cover Instructions:

Piece scraps together, pressing seams and trimming to straighten edges to make a 10.5" x 13.5" rectangle.

Layer the Following: Inside Front Cover Piece (Right Side Down) Foam Stabilizer (Centered) Front Cover Piece (Right Sides Up)

Baste layers together and quilt as desired. Square up edges if needed and add binding.

Measure to find the center of front cover. Draw a line with erasible fabric marker or pen.



Sew down this line. (Image 1) Set front cover aside

Needle Page Instructions (Make 2):

Place clear vinyl pieces 1 inch from sides and 1 inch from top for each piece of flannel fabric. (Image 2)

Sew with a long stitch to secure sides and bottom.

Place two pieces of flannel right sides together. Add batting piece, lining up top width of batting to top of flannel. (Image 3)

Pin or clip to hold together.

Turn Right side out and push out corners. Press if desired.

Fold bottom fabric edges over, using one side to cover the edge of batting. (Image 4)

Tuck in corners and clip or pin to secure.

Sew 1/8" from edge to close page.



Measure to find the center of each

page. Draw a line with desired marking tool. Sew down this line as you did for the front cover.

Assembly:

Place front cover with inside cover facing up.

Add each page lining up the middle stitches and pin in place. Sew down this line several times to secure pages to book. Add labels and machine sewing needles to your pages.

Sew along the top and sides.
