Modern 60° Ruler Quilt

60X80

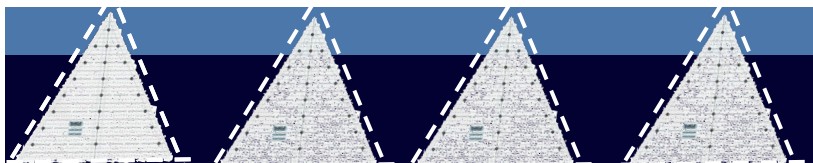


*Fabric this quilt takes a lot of fabric because we are cutting one direction.

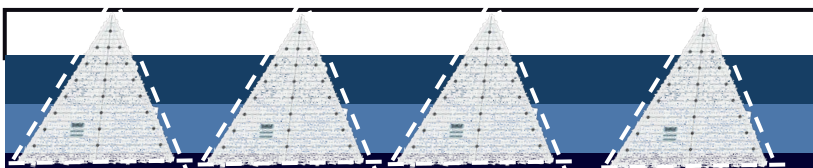

| Light Blue- |  | .5 yards |
| Medium Blue- |  | .5 yards |
| Dark Blue- |  | 4.5 yards |
| Bright Blue- |  | .5 yards |
| Gray Blue- |  | .5 yards |
| Center light Blue- |  | .5 yards |
| Center Med Blue |  | .5 yards |
| White- |  | 1.5 yards |
| Backing- | 3.5 yards | |
| Batting- | 3.5 yards | |

Cut 3.25" wide X WOF for the strips
 Wide dark blue strip 7.75" wide X WOF
 Small outer dark blue strip 1.75" X WOF
 Grace 60° Ruler
 My Comfort Cutter with Guide.
 Sew using ¼" seam allowance.





Cut around 60° triangle ruler to make an 8" equal lateral triangle.



Set out triangles into design or pattern you like. Begin piecing three triangles together to make a Half Hexagon.

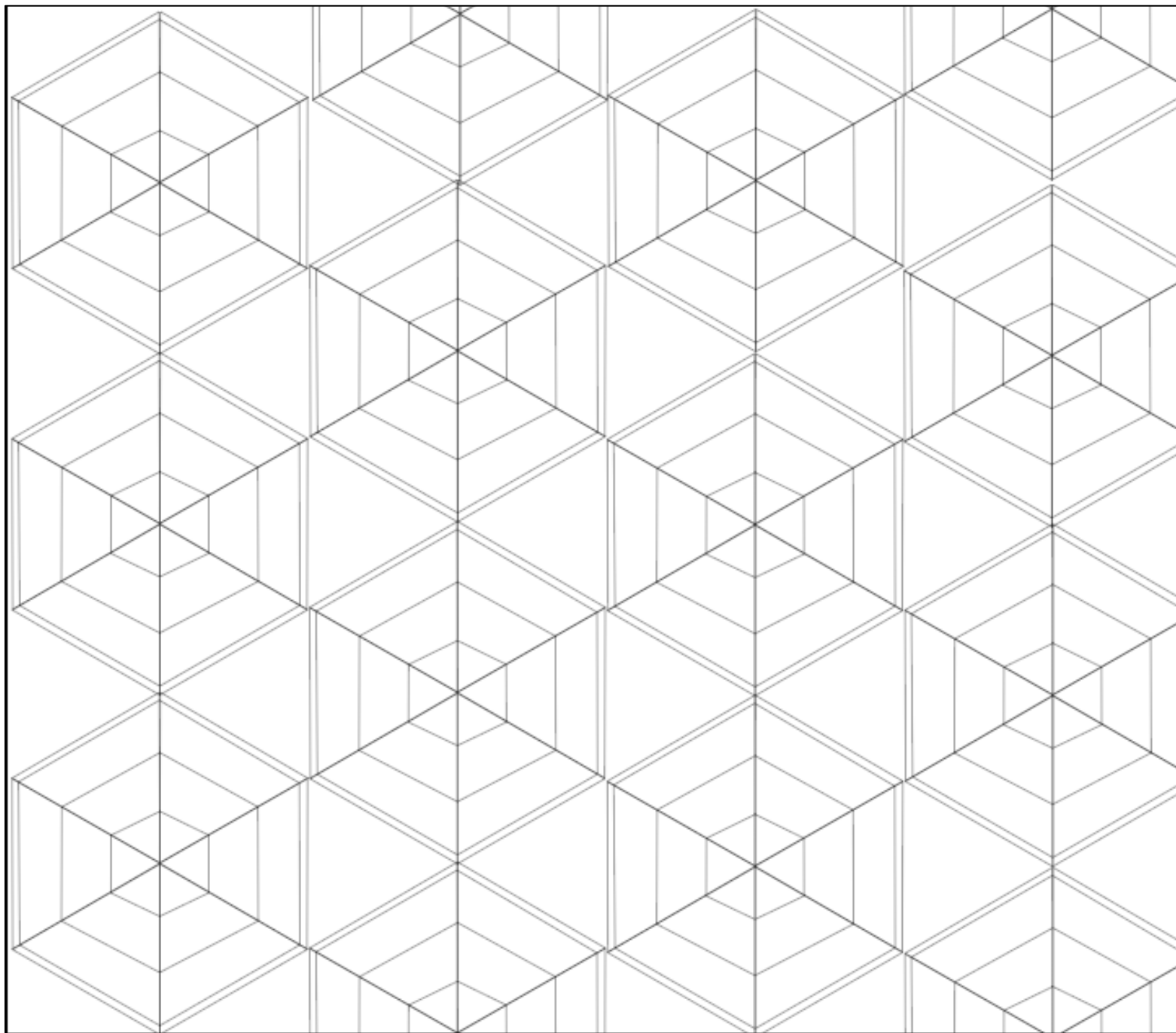


Once you have the Triangles sewn together in groups of three then sew the groups of three into six and then six into however completes one row. Next sew all your rows together.



Cut off excess to square up top and bottom using $\frac{1}{4}$ seam allowance as you are cutting.
