



Love Birds Quilt







General Notes

- The finished size is 54" X 30"
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4 inch unless specified

Cutting

White Solid

- 16 squares 4" (Unit A)
- 6 squares 11/2" (Unit E)
- 4 rectangles 4"x11" (Unit G)
- 2 rectangles 4"x 7½" (Unit P)
- 6 squares 6³/₄" (Unit U)
- 12 squares 21/2" (Unit W)
- 48 squares 2⁷/₈"(Unit X)
- 6 squares 4³/₄"(Unit Z)

Navy Blue Print

- 7 squares 4" (Unit B)
- 2 squares 1½"(Unit F)

Blue Print

• 5 squares 4" (Unit C)

Light Blue Print

- 3 squares 4" (Unit D)
- 36 squares 4³/₄"(Unit Y)

Dark Red Print

- 7 squares 4" (Unit H)
- 2 squares 11/2" (Unit L)

Red Print

- 5 squares 4"(Unit I)
- 6 squares 6³/₄" (Unit T)
- 48 squares 2½"(Unit V)

Pink Print

• 3 squares 4"(Unit J)

Red Solid

- 2 rectangles 4"x 2½" (Unit M)
- 2 rectangles 4"x 2 " (Unit O)
- 2 rectangles 4"x 7½" (Unit Q)
- 2 squares 4" (Unit R)

Orange Solid


• 4 squares 11/2"(Unit N)

Blue Solid

• 2 rectangles 42"x2"(Unit S)

Piecing

1 To make a half square triangle, place one square on top of the other with right sides together. Sew along the diagonal and trim ¼" away from the seam. Then press open.



2 Use the directions in step 1 to make 5 half square triangles from Unit A and Unit B





3 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit A and Unit C



4 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit B and Unit C




5 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit C and Unit D



6 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit A and Unit D



7 To stitch-and-flip, place a small square in the corner of a larger rectangle, right sides together. Stitch along the diagonal of the small square, cut off the excess, then press open



8 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit B and Unit E




9 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit C and Unit E

10 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit B and Unit F



11 Join Unit A, 2 pieces made in step 2, and the piece made in step 8



12 Join the piece from step 3, Unit C, and the pieces made in steps 9 and 10




13 Join the pieces from steps 2, 4, 5, and 6



 ${\bf 14}$ Join 2 pieces from step 2 and Unit G



15 Join the piece from steps 11-13, then add Unit G, then add the piece from step 14



16 Use the directions in step 1 to make 5 half square triangles from Unit A and Unit H

17 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit A and Unit J



18 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit I and Unit J



19 Use the directions in step 1 to make 1 half square triangle from Unit H and Unit J



20 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit H and Unit E



21 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit J and Unit L



22Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip in any corner with Unit I and Unit L



23 Join the piece made in step 20, 2 pieces made in step 16, and Unit A



24 Join the pieces made in steps 21 and 22, Unit I and a piece made in step 16




25 Join pieces made in steps 17, 18, 19 and 16.



26 Join Unit G and 2 of the pieces made in step 16



27 Join the pieces made in steps 23-25. Then add Unit G. Then add the piece from step 26




28 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitchand-flip Unit E in the top-left and top-right corners of both of Unit M. Then stitch-andflip Unit N in the bottom-left corner of one piece and bottom-right corner of the other




29 Use the instructions in step 6 to stitch-andflip Unit N in the top-left corner of one Unit O and top-right in the other Unit O



30 Mark with both of Unit P along opposite diagonals




31 Align the markings from the previous step to opposite corners of Unit Q. Stitch along the markings and cut ¼" away from the seam




32 Press the pieces from the previous step open




33 Join the pieces made in steps 28, 29 and 32



34 Join the pieces made in steps 15, 27 and 33. Then add Unit S to the top and bottom



35 Use the 8-at-a-time half-square triangle method, by placing Unit T and Unit U right sides together. Then mark the diagonal, horizontal and vertical center lines. Stitch on either side of the diagonal lines. Then cut along all of the markings. Repeat with 6 sets of squares.



36 Press all of the half square triangles open.



37Join 2 of the pieces made in the previous step and one of Unit V.




38 Join 2 of Unit V and one of Unit W.






39 Join 2 the pieces made in steps 37 and one of the pieces made in step 38




Make 12

40 Start making 4-at-a-time flying geese by placing 2 of Unit X in the diagonal corners of Unit Y. Mark the centers diagonally, stitch on either side of the diagonal, then cut along the marking.



Repeat 12 times

41 Press you seams, then place another Unit X in the corner. Mark the center diagonally, stitch on either side of the diagonal, then cut along the marking.



Repeat 24 times


42 Press the seams to make the flying geese.



Make 48


43 Sew 2 of the pieces made in the previous

step together.




Make 24

44 Use the 3 color-hour-glass method by placing Unit X and Unit Z right sides together. Mark the center diagonally, stitch on either side of the diagonal, and cut along the marking.




Repeat 6 times

45 Place 2 of Unit X right sides together. Mark the center diagonally, stitch on either side of the diagonal, and cut along the marking.



Repeat 6 times

46 Place the pieces made in steps 44 and 45 right sides together with the diagonal lines aligned in the same direction. Mark the center diagonally perpendicular to the seam, stitch on either side of the diagonal, and cut along the marking.




Repeat 12 times

47Press your seams.



Make 24

48 Join 2 of the pieces made in the previous step.




49 Join 2 of the pieces made in step 43 and a piece made in step 48.






50 Join a piece made in step 39 and 2 of the pieces made in step 49.






51 Join 5 of the pieces made in step 39 and 4 of the pieces made in step 49.



Make 2



52 Assemble the pieces made in steps 34, 50 and 51. Congratulations on your finished quilt!
