## Supply List with Links

- [webbing kits](#)
- [strap hardware kits](#) (antique brass & nickel)
- zipper for interior pocket (8" for Regular size, or 6" for Mini size)
- zippers available for Mini Making backpack: [zipper kit](#) (includes 18" zipper for main closure & 10" zipper for alternate pocket) OR an [individual 18" zipper](#) (if making the Mini with front slip pocket)
- [full hardware/webbing kit](#) for Regular size Making Backpack

## The Making Backpack Scrappy Version- Large Backpack Cutting Instructions

Each piece is made slightly bigger for wiggle room and needs to be cut down to size according to the pattern by Noodlehead Patterns.

## Front Main Panel

- Cut (60) 1 1/2" squares
- Cut (1) 10 1/2"x 13

Instructions:

1. Sew the 1 1/2" squares together in a 5 by 12 grid
2. Sew the 10 1/2"x 13 piece onto the bottom of the grid
3. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern

## Back Main Panel

- Cut (16) 1 1/2" by 13" strips

Instructions:

1. Sew all 16 strips together along width of the strip.
2. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern

## Bottom Gusset

- Cut (31) 1 1/2" by 6 1/2" strips

Instructions:

1. Sew all 31 strips together along width of the strip.
2. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern

## Top Gusset

- Cut (23) 1 1/2" by 6 1/2" strips

Instructions:

1. Sew all 23 strips together along width of the strip.
2. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern

## Front Pocket

- Cut (144) 1 1/2" squares

Instructions:

1. Sew the 1 1/2" squares together in a 12 by 12 square grid
2. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern

## Alternate Front Pocket

- Cut (190) 1 1/2" squares

Instructions:

1. Sew the 1 1/2" squares together in a 6 by 15 grid
2. Trim to the correct size according to the pattern.
