# Quilting with African Fabric by Kena Tangi Dorsey 


( $36^{1 / 2 "} \times 36^{1 / 2 ")}$
DESCRIPTION: Using African Wax Print Fabrics to create a beautiful Wall Hanging Quilt

## FABRICS NEEDED:

- Teal/Turquoise African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Lavender Solid or Print: 3/4 Yard or (3) Fat Quarters
- Purple African Wax Print: (2) Fat Quarters
- Blue African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Yellow African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Blue Solid or Print for Borders:: $3 / 8$ Yard or (4) $21 / 2 "$ strips WOF

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: (finished size of Flying Geese Blocks are 8 3/4" $x 16^{3 / 4}$ ")

- CUT 12 - LAVENDER SQUARES $87 / 8$ " x $87 / 8$ "
- CUT 4 - YELLOW SQUARES $87 / 8$ " $\times 7 / 8$ "
- CUT 4 - PURPLE RECTANGLES $87 / 8 " \times 167 / 8 "$
- CUT 2 - BLUE RECTANGLES $87 / 8$ " x $167 / 8 "$
- CUT 2 - TEAL/TURQUOISE RECTANGLES $87 / 8$ " x 16 7/8"
- CUT 4 - BLUE $21 / 2$ " by WOF


## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. On the wrong side of all twelve LAVENDER $87 / 8$ " squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner.
2. On the wrong side of all four YELLOW $87 / 8$ " squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner.
3. Place one LAVENDER square right side down on a BLUE $87 / 8$ " $\times 167 / 8$ " rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim $1 / 4$ " from the seam. Repeat this step with another YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
4. Place one LAVENDER square right side down on a PURPLE $87 / 8 " \times 167 / 8$ " rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim $1 / 4$ " from the seam. Repeat this step with another LAVENDER square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
5. Place one LAVENDER square right side down on the left side a PURPLE $87 / 8$ " $\times 167 / 8$ " rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim $1 / 4 "$ from the seam. Repeat this step but with a YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
6. Place one LAVENDER square right side down on the left side of a TURQUOISE $87 / 8$ " $\times 167 / 8$ " rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim $1 / 4$ " from the seam. Repeat this step but with a YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
7. TRIM all Flying Geese blocks to measure $81 / 2$ " $\times 16^{1 / 2 "}$
8. Arrange the flying geese blocks using the color and direction pattern pictured above. Sew the blocks together using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
9. Sew one MULTI-COLOR strip to the left and one to the right side of the quilt, and one MULTI-COLOR strip to the top and one along the bottom. *optional outer border: repeat adding 4 strips to outer border
