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Quilting with African Fabric by Kena Tangi Dorsey



(36 ½" x 36 ½")

DESCRIPTION: Using African Wax Print Fabrics to create a beautiful Wall Hanging Quilt

FABRICS NEEDED:

- Teal/Turquoise African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Lavender Solid or Print: 3/4 Yard or (3) Fat Quarters Purple African Wax Print: (2) Fat Quarters Blue African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter

- Yellow African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Blue Solid or Print for Borders:: 3/8 Yard or (4) 2 1/2" strips WOF

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: (finished size of Flying Geese Blocks are 8 ¾ x 16 ¾ ") CUT 12 - LAVENDER SQUARES 8 ½ " x 8 ½ " CUT 4 - YELLOW SQUARES 8 ½ " x 8 ½ " CUT 4 - PURPLE RECTANGLES 8 ½ " x 16 ½ "

- CUT 2 BLUE RECTANGLES 8 %" x 16 %"
 CUT 2 TEAL/TURQUOISE RECTANGLES 8 %" x 16 %"
 CUT 4 BLUE 2 ½" by WOF

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- On the wrong side of all twelve LAVENDER 8 7/8" squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner. 1.
- On the wrong side of all four YELLOW 8 % squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner. 2.
- Place one LAVENDER square right side down on a BLUE 8 %" x 16 %" rectangle. Sew along the guideline. 3. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step with another YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
- Place one LAVENDER square right side down on a PURPLE 8 %" x 16 %" rectangle. Sew along the 4. guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step with another LAVENDER square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
- Place one LAVENDER square right side down on the left side a PURPLE 8 7/8" x 16 7/8" rectangle. Sew 5. along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step but with a YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
- Place one LAVENDER square right side down on the left side of a TURQUOISE 8 %" x 16 %" rectangle. 6. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step but with a YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
- TRIM all Flying Geese blocks to measure 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" 7.
- 8. Arrange the flying geese blocks using the color and direction pattern pictured above. Sew the blocks together using a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Sew one MULTI-COLOR strip to the left and one to the right side of the quilt, and one MULTI-COLOR 9. strip to the top and one along the bottom. *optional outer border: repeat adding 4 strips to outer border
