Thank you for joining us at the Grace Company! Here is some written instructions on how to create our Baby Bubbles Blanket.

Materials

- Light Blue Solid
 ½ yard
- Turquoise Solid
 ½ yard
- Pink Solid
 ½ yard
- Grey Print
 ½ yard
- Green Solid
 ½ yard
- White Solid¼ yard
- Minky Print1 yard of for squares1 yard of for Backing
- Batting 1½ yard

Notes

- Finished size: 36" x 38"
- Use a ¼" seam allowance

Cut Your Fabric


- Light Blue Solid
 11 Squares 5½"
- Turquoise Solid
 10 Squares 5½"
- Pink Solid12 Squares 5½"
- Grey Print 11 Squares 5½"
- Green Solid16 Squares 2"7 Squares 5½"
- White Solid32 Squares 2"
- Minky Print
 20 Squares 5½"

Piece Your Block Strips

• Start by piecing together 8 blocks to make a long strip.




 Create 6 more of these strips with blocks in different orders. Label the strips in order so the layout of strips stay organized




Piece Your Flowers


 Align 3 small white blocks to the corners of a block. Align a small green block to the other corner. Sew diagonally from point to point. Repeat this step 4 times



 Put right sides together and align the green triangles together and sew along the edge.
 Do this twice.



 Sew the two pieces together to create your flower. Make sure to align the green triangles.



 Repeat the last 3 steps 3 more times to create the other 3 flowers.



• Sew them together to make a strip of flowers.



Putting the Quilt Together

 Now place the batting on the frame without any backing. Take the first strip of blocks and place right side on the batting. Use the quilting machine to tack down the bottom edge of the strip.



 Fold the strip over and tack down the rightmost block on the outside edge. Move the machine off the block so the bottom of the block won't be tacked down when going across.




 Use the stitch-in-the-ditch method to go up along the left edge of the block



 Repeat this method for the entire strip making sure that the bottom edge of the block does not get tacked down.



 The bottom edges will now appear as pockets on the batting. Take a handful of stuffing and place inside the pocket.



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- Do this for every pocket on the strip.
- Put a new strip right sides together on top of the stuffed pockets. Pin down the aligned edges. Tack it down with one line straight across.




 Fold down and repeat the process so pockets are made on this strip




 Continue to do so until you have 3 strips completely done and stuffed.




 Place the flower strip right side facing the last strip completed. Pin and tack down with one straight line.



 Tack down the large blocks to make big pockets.



 Before stuffing them, stitch-in-the-ditch along all the white blocks except the middle white triangle along the bottom edges so only the flowers will be pockets.



 Stuff the flower pockets trying to not get stuffing under the white triangle. Stitch-inthe-ditch the white triangle and the middle colored square.



 Place a strip right side down on top of the flower row and tack it down with one straight line. Continue the block strip process with the last 4 strips.



 Take the batting off of the frame and trim around the edges. Sew on the backing and it is finished!
