Materials


- Hat
 - 12"x WOF
- Striped Shirt
 - 8"x WOF
- Plaid pants
 - 11"x WOF
- Backing
 - 1 yards
- Batting
 - 1 yard
- Batting
 - 1 yard
- 2 Arms
 - 10"x 14" rectangle
- 2 Hands and 4 Boots
 - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of black fabric for templates
- 2 Hearts
 - 1 fat quarter red for template
- Beard and Mustache
 - ½ yard white for templates
- · Needle and thread for hand sewing
- Stuffing good quality

Notes

- Finished size:
- WOF=width of fabric
- Use a ¼" seam allowance

Strip Piece Body

1 Attach your backing and batting to your frame. Then strip piece the fabric for the hat, striped shirt and plaid pants onto your batting.




2 Cut your fabric into 2 pieces 17" wide.



17" wide - Make 2

3 Cut both parts of the Hat template and tape or glue together. Cut the 4¾"x 4" Cutout template.

4 Trace the Hat template in the hat area. Measure 3" from either side in striped shirt area at the bottom. Draw a line from the measurement to the edge of the marking for the hat. Use the 4¾"x 4" Cutout template to mark either side of the bottom of the plaid pants fabric.



5 Cut along your markings and repeat with the other strip piece.



Make 2

6 Use the Hand template to cut 2 pieces from black fabric. Join the hands to the 10"x 14" rectangle for the arms.



Make 2

7 Fold in half and stitch right sides together. Turn inside out and stuff.

8 Use the Boots template to cut 4 pieces from black.



Make 4

- 9 Stitch right sides together. Turn inside out and stuff.
- **10** Stitch the 2 body pieces together with the arms and boots pinned inside, leaving an opening for stuffing. Turn inside out and stuff and stitch close.
- 11 Use templates to cut 2 each of the nose, mustache, heart, and beard. For each shape join right sides together, cut an opening, turn inside out and stuff. Then hand stitch the pieces onto the body and stitch the hands to the body at the center.
